Hot Springs

Sierra Hot Springs, Sierraville
30 minute drive from Guesthouse

Set on 600 acres bordering National Forest land, Sierra Hot Springs offers a serene retreat with multiple options for hot spring pools to enjoy. The property features a lodge with a restaurant, pool complex which includes an enclosed Hot Pool (110-112°), two cold plunges, a large outdoor Warm Pool, and shower facilities. Children are welcome with some restrictions outlined in the Kid's Code of Conduct policy. Robes and towels will be provided by Guesthouse.

Hot Spring Amenities

Free Wi-Fi at the Main Lodge or Globe Hotel

The Temple Dome Area is the main pool area and consists of The Hot Pool (110-112°) which is enclosed in a large geodesic dome, featuring stained glass, skylights and two cold plunges. Outside the dome, the large Warm Pool (98-100°) is complemented by a large sundeck and a Dry Sauna.

The Meditation Pool (98-100°) is outdoors, surrounded by rock tile. In this faux natural pool, you step down rock steps into a serene outdoor hot pool that is ideal for enjoying the star studded skies.

The Phoenix Baths (95-96°) are private tubs which are filled with fresh water between each guest. The Phoenix Baths are first come, first serve and take about 20-30 minutes to fill.

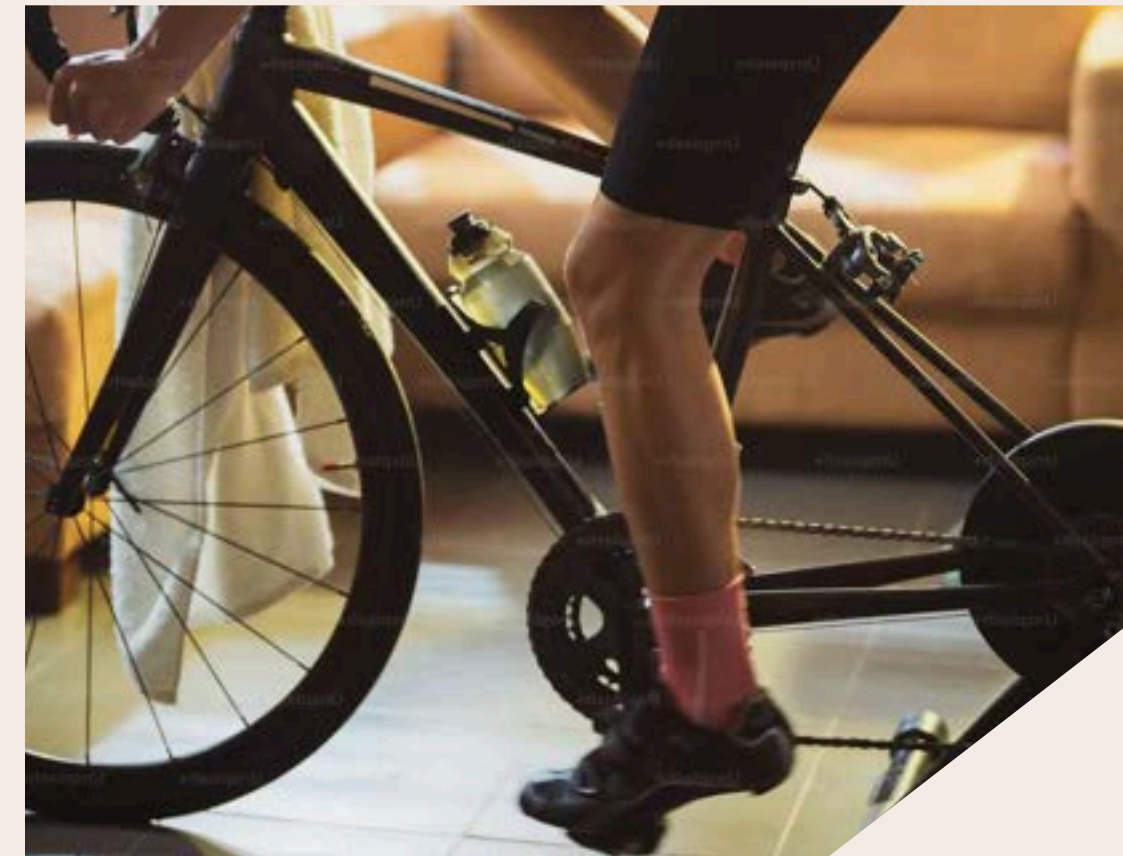

Enjoy an introductory 50 minute horseback riding trail through the Sierra Nevada wilderness. Longer and more advanced rides can be arranged.

Palisades Aerial Tram & Viewpoint

Palisades Tahoe, Olympic Valley
15 minute drive from Guesthouse

An amazing way to experience the Olympic Valley view, located at Palisades Ski Resort. The aerial tram is a ten minute ride climbing 2,000 feet to High Camp at 8,200ft and offers panoramic views of Lake Tahoe and the surrounding Sierra Nevada mountains. When you arrive at the top at High Camp, enjoy indoor and outdoor seating on the patio with snacks and beverages available.

Mountain or Gravel Biking

Dirt Gypsy, Truckee

Snowshoeing is easy to learn and a great activity for the entire family to experience together. Tahoe Donner offers private, guided tours for individuals and groups to learn basic skills and gain knowledge about the local flora and fauna. Smoke Door is a Japanese inspired, wood-fired restaurant at the state line of California and Nevada, about 30 minutes from Guesthouse. Smoke Door offers a 6 and 10 course tasting menu as well as a la carte in a small and intimate setting with a full bar. For the menu, Executive Chef Tyler Burges uses a mix of locally sourced ingredients combined with seasonal items from different regions of Japan that are flown in multiple times a week. The essence of wood fire is subtly woven into the menu including the specialty cocktails. Alcoholic beverages are not included.
