This Privacy Policy ("Privacy Policy") describes the privacy practices of MediaMosaic, Inc. d/b/a The Mosaic Company ("Mosaic," "we," "us," or "our").

Information We Collect

Information You Provide Voluntarily

We may collect personal information that you voluntarily provide when you:

Information Collected Automatically

When you visit our website, we may automatically collect certain technical and usage information, including:



- IP address
- Browser type and version
- Device information
- Operating system
- Referral sources
- Pages visited and website interactions
- Date and time of access
- Cookie or similar technology identifiers
- Other website usage and analytics data

The specific information collected may depend on your device, browser settings, and the technologies used on our website.

How We Use Information

Mosaic may use personal information to:

- Respond to inquiries, requests, and communications
 - Provide requested services, content, and information
 - Deliver updates regarding our capabilities, events, and insights
 - Improve website functionality, performance, and user experience
 - Administer programs, events, and registrations
 - Maintain and improve our business operations

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Cookies and Similar Technologies

Depending on the technologies used on our website, these may include cookies or similar technologies used to:

- Remember preferences
- Analyze traffic and usage patterns

Information Sharing and Disclosure

Data Security
