Athletics Advisory Council

Charge:

The primary mission of the Athletics Advisory Council is to discuss, review, and provide advisory recommendations to the Director of Athletics and President on topics, including, but not limited to student-athlete wellbeing, academic integrity, academic support, gender equity issues, diversity issues, and the commitment to compliance with NCAA and Southland policies and procedures. The Athletics Advisory Council serves at the discretion of the President of the University.

Membership:

Voting members are one (1) Faculty Athletics Representative (FAR) appointed by the President of the University, Provost, three (3) faculty members appointed by the President of the University, three (3) faculty members nominated by the Faculty Senate and appointed by the President of the University, one (1) staff member appointed by the President of the University, the NCAA Certifying Official, President of the Privateer Athletic Foundation Board, President of the Student Government Association, and President of the Student-Athlete Advisory Council.

NonVoting Members are the Director of Athletics, senior female Administrator, and Associate Athletics Director for Compliance and Student-Athlete Services
