Graduate Council

Charge:

The purpose of the Graduate Council is to recommend and advise the Provost and Director of the Graduate School on Graduate School policy, Graduate Faculty policy, and graduate curriculum policy, including advising on the procedure for review of and compliance with those policies. The Council is responsible for duties including, but not limited to review of graduate faculty appointment criteria, graduate faculty applications, advocacy for quality in graduate programs and representation of graduate faculty concerns to the administration.

Membership:

Two members from each college appointed by the Dean of the college. Members must have current graduate faculty standing at either the associate or full level. Appointments are for a three-year term beginning in the first day of fall semester. The Dean must make appointments by the end of spring semester.
