Charge:

The Council provides advice and assistance to the Director for Research and Economic Development on the development of planning and policy for research at the University of New Orleans. Membership:

The Research Council is an advisory body which consists of the Director, a representative from each of the colleges and the Library as recommended by the Dean, a representative from each of the Board of Regents approved centers and institutes and the Associate Director for Research and a representative from the Faculty and Administrative Senate Board.
