The reforms add the following: a traditional preamble, order of succession, inauguration, concise cabinet, a feasible ratification portion, demerit code and system, presidential pardon, right to petition, social media responsibilities for vice president, supremacy clause, and more. The reforms remove the following: gendered language and non-inclusive language, and non-functioning organisms within the SGA.
