A Bill

Whereas, the Encore is registered with the Office of Student Involvement and Leadership;

Whereas, the GHOST TOWN is necessary to the UNO community because unconventional and fantastical events such as this are designed to, through creativity and collaboration, showcase the many limitless talents of UNO. Ghost Town will feature the use of augmented reality to enhance the attraction and deliver a more memorable experience. Encore will partner with members of the UNO Theatre Department and UNO Film Department for the design, fulfillment, and management of this event.

Furthermore, there will be no nudity, no smoking, alcohol, and especially no drugs or firearms. This will be a safe event for all members above the age of 11 of the community who can purchase a ticket and enjoy a great night of scares. Additionally, the three main reasons for this funding amount is;

1. For Encore to make enough in ticket sales and now self-fund all future Encore events.
2. Increase UNO population by showing local high schools the talent UNO has to offer when deciding the college of their choice
3. To start a Palliative Care research project with the American Cancer Society. Additionally, Cross World Africa and High Voltage will receive 10% of the ticket sales for their continued progress and work as non-profits.

- II. ALL UNUSED FUNDS SHALL REVERT BACK TO THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION AT THE END OF THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR.
- III. SEE ATTACHED BUDGET.

IV. Encore SHALL REPORT BACK TO THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION WITHIN 30 DAYS UPON COMPLETION OF THE EVENT.
