



Dr. John L. Renne is Co-Director of CETOC. Dr. Renne is a Professor and Director of the Center for Urban and Environmental Solutions at Florida Atlantic University. He is best known as a global expert on transit-orient development (TOD). His work bridges real estate development and transportation infrastructure, including resilience. Dr. Renne has published four books and over 130 publications that focus on TOD, land use, transportation, sustainability, and resilience. According to Google Scholar, his work has been cited over 3,500 times. He has led over \$5 million in external research funding for local, state, and federal agencies, and the Kresge Foundation. In addition, he oversees a \$4 million endowment with the MacArthur Foundation in partnership with leading real estate developers in South Florida. He recently joined the leadership team of the new \$26 million NSF Engineering Research Center for Smart Streetscapes (CS3), a collaboration of multiple universities to advance livable, safe and inclusive communities through new streetscape applications built upon real-time and hyper-local streetscape intelligence.
