

DRONE DEFENSE PROTOCOL

Drone Observation Card

Six Elements:

- 1. Location** Direction, landmark, or grid reference
- 2. Altitude** Rooftop level, treetop level, significantly higher
- 3. Configuration** Platform type; payload visible?
- 4. Behavior** Hover, transit, circle, systematic
- 5. Duration** Time from first observed to report
- 6. Departure** Direction; last known position

Verbal Format: "Contact [direction] of [landmark], approx [altitude], [platform], [behavior], [X] min, [active/departed]."

Note: Incomplete reports are still worth making.

DRONE DEFENSE PROTOCOL

Tier Classification System



Tier 1	Routine: Low concern: monitor and log
Indicators	Incidental activity. No sensitive proximity, brief duration.
Action	Document. Increase awareness. No escalation.
Tier 2	Elevated: Moderate concern: assess and notify
Indicators	Sensitive proximity, unusual behavior, intent unclear.
Action	Notify supervisor. Brief leadership. Law enforcement on standby.
Tier 3	High: High concern: respond and coordinate
Indicators	Direct threat indicators or critical area penetration.
Action	Alert leadership. Contact law enforcement now.

Assessment factors: Location • Behavior • Duration • Interaction
When uncertain, classify higher. Downgrade with evidence.
