1. Who we are

2. Information we collect

Depending on how you interact with CoreVetta, we may collect the following information:

- Name, email address and company name.
- Information you submit through the Navigator assessment or other CoreVetta services.
- Information you provide when contacting us or booking a clarity call.
- Website usage information, such as IP address, browser type, device information, pages visited and date/time of access.

3. How we use your information

We use personal information to:

- Deliver the CoreVetta services you request.
- Generate assessment outcomes, reports and related guidance.
- Respond to enquiries and provide customer support.
- Process payments and manage customer records.
- Improve our website, platform and services.
- Maintain security and comply with legal obligations.

We do not sell your personal information.



4. Lawful basis for processing

Where UK GDPR applies, we process personal information where it is necessary to provide our services, comply with legal obligations, pursue legitimate business interests, or where you have given consent.

5. Sharing your information

We may share information with trusted service providers who help us operate CoreVetta, including providers of website hosting, payment processing, cloud infrastructure, analytics and customer support. These providers are required to protect information appropriately and only process it for authorised purposes.

We may also disclose information where required by law or to protect our legal rights.

6. Data security

We use reasonable technical and organisational measures to protect personal information against unauthorised access, loss, misuse or disclosure. No online service can guarantee absolute security, but we take protection of information seriously.

7. Data retention

We retain personal information only for as long as necessary to provide our services, comply with legal obligations, resolve disputes or protect legitimate business interests. Information is securely deleted when no longer required.

8. Your rights

Depending on applicable law, you may have rights to access, correct, delete or restrict the use of your personal information, object to certain processing, request a copy of your information, or withdraw consent where processing is based on consent.
