

# Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how UNICAMPUS LTD (C 104561), operating as MediCampus Europeo - MCE ("MCE", "MediCampus Europeo", "we", "us" or "our") uses cookies and similar technologies on our website.

## 1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. Cookies allow a website to recognise your device, remember your preferences, operate securely, improve functionality, measure website performance and, where applicable, support analytics, marketing or embedded third-party services.

Similar technologies may include pixels, tags, local storage, scripts, SDKs and other tracking technologies.

## 2. Why we use cookies

We use cookies and similar technologies to:

- operate and secure the website;
- remember your cookie preferences;
- enable website forms and basic website functionality;
- protect the website from spam, fraud or misuse;
- understand how visitors use the website;
- improve website performance and content;
- display embedded content, such as videos or booking tools;
- measure campaigns and communications, where applicable;
- comply with legal and regulatory requirements.

## 3. Types of cookies we use

Our website may use the following categories of cookies.

### 3.1 Strictly necessary cookies

Strictly necessary cookies are required for the website to function properly. They may be used for:

- website security;
- page navigation;
- form functionality;

- cookie consent storage;
- load balancing;
- spam prevention;
- basic website operations.

These cookies do not require your consent because they are necessary to provide the website or a service requested by you.

### **3.2 Functional cookies**

Functional cookies help the website remember choices you make and provide enhanced functionality.

They may support:

- embedded videos;
- booking tools;
- chat or contact tools;
- language or interface preferences;
- improved website experience.

Functional cookies are used only where required consent has been obtained, unless they are strictly necessary for a service requested by you.

### **3.3 Analytics and performance cookies**

Analytics cookies help us understand how visitors use the website. They may collect information such as:

- pages visited;
- time spent on pages;
- traffic sources;
- device and browser information;
- interactions with website elements;
- aggregated usage statistics.

We use analytics information to improve the website, content, usability and performance.

Analytics cookies are used only where required consent has been obtained.

### **3.4 Marketing and tracking cookies**

Marketing cookies may be used to measure campaign performance, understand user interaction with communications or support advertising and remarketing activities.

Marketing cookies may be set by us or by third-party providers. They are used only where consent has been obtained.

### **3.5 Embedded content and third-party cookies**

Our website may include embedded content or third-party services, such as:

- YouTube videos;

- Google services;
- booking tools;
- CRM, chatbot, AI agent or live chat tools;
- social media links or embedded content;
- analytics or tag management tools.

These third parties may set their own cookies or similar technologies when you interact with their services. Their use of cookies is governed by their own privacy and cookie policies.

## 4. Cookie consent management

We use CookieScript to manage cookie consent and cookie preferences on our website.

When you first visit our website, CookieScript may display a cookie banner or preference centre. Through this banner or preference centre, you can:

- accept all cookies;
- reject non-essential cookies;
- manage cookie categories;
- change your preferences;
- withdraw consent.

Non-essential cookies, including analytics, marketing and certain third-party cookies, should only be placed on your device after you have given consent.

Continuing to browse the website, scrolling, closing the banner or ignoring the banner will not be treated as consent for non-essential cookies.
