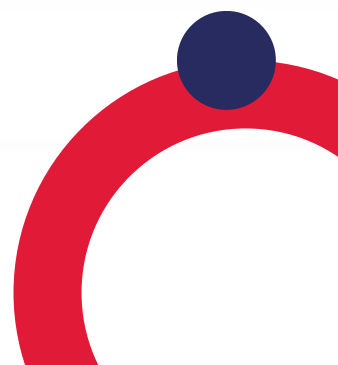

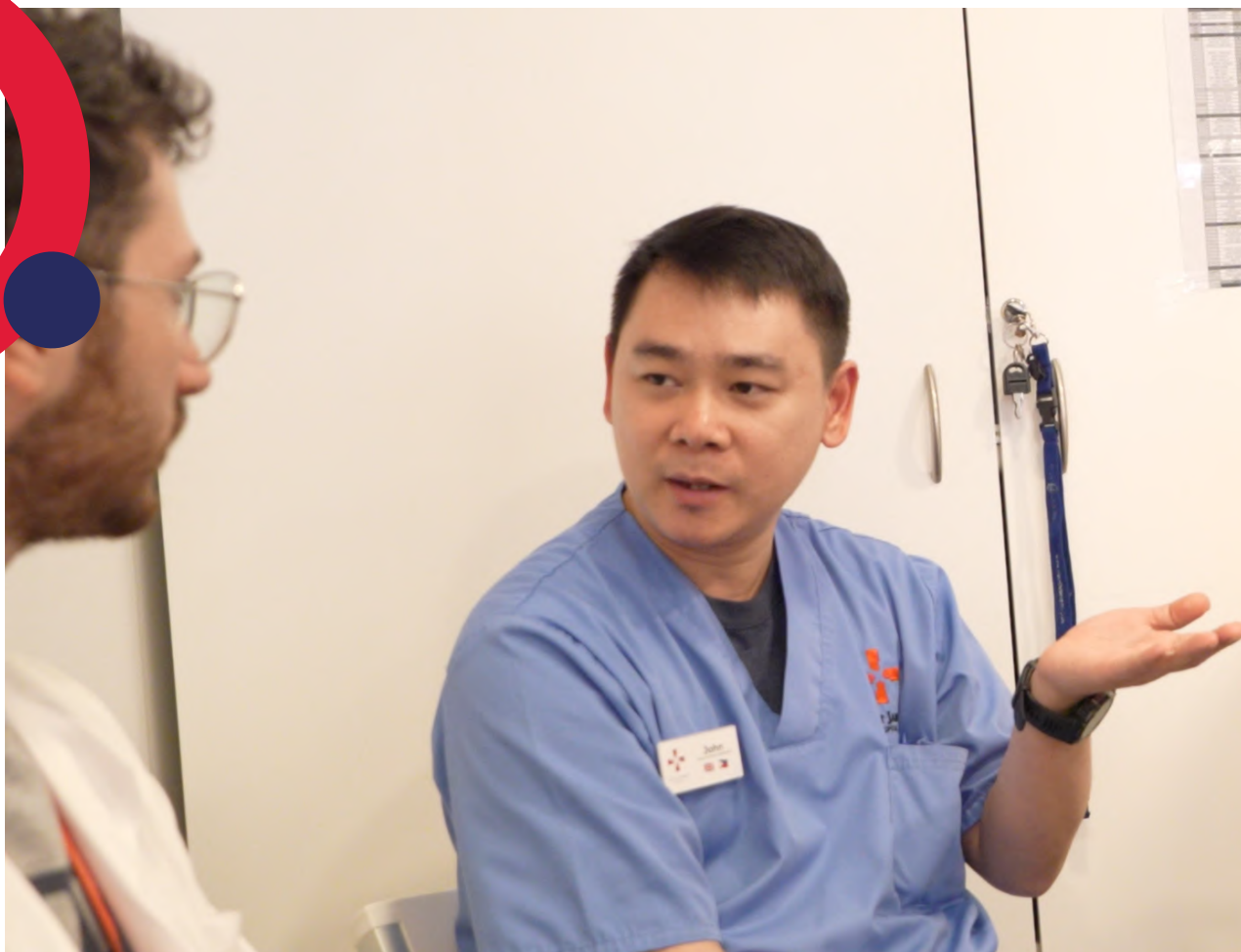
Through a meticulous evaluation of candidates' skills, aptitudes and motivation, MCE cultivates a diverse, highly motivated student body aligned with the University's values.

The Degree Program in Medicine is taught in English by high-profile professors (360 ECTS, mandatory attendance). Graduates receive the title of Doctor of General Medicine (MD).

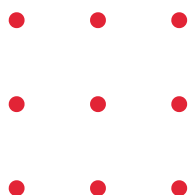
Duration: 6 years.

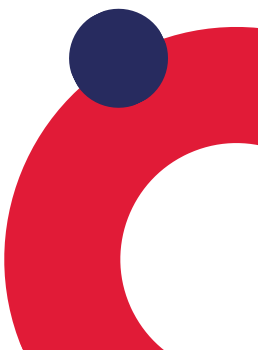


MCE offers its students a high-level practical and scientific education. Classes are taught by professors coming from some of the most renowned European universities, who follow a teaching method characterized by a close connection between theoretical and practical lessons.

The MediCampus Europeo and all its study programs are accredited by the Malta Further and Higher Education Authority (MFHEA) and it is under the Maltese Education Act. MFHEA is a full member of the European Association for Quality Assurance in Higher Education (ENQA).

Medical studies at MCE lead to a degree in Human Medicine, entitling graduates to obtain a license to practice throughout the EU and in many other countries, and it is fully equivalent to medical examinations and human medicine degrees from all other EU countries.

The degree in Medicine obtained at MediCampus Europeo holds great value, as our graduates receive a diploma issued by Trakia University.

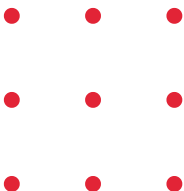




The Medicine degree program at MediCampus Europeo is delivered in partnership with the renowned Trakia University, a state university located in Bulgaria which is one of the country's most famous universities.

It currently hosts approximately 10,000 students and includes 9 faculties, offering 43 bachelor's degrees, 71 master's programs, and 90 doctoral programs. Trakia University is accredited by the National Evaluation and Accreditation Agency (NEAA) under the Bulgarian Council of Ministers.

MCE adheres to the "Bologna Process" (European Higher Education System), using the SEIS European standards that define uniform education protocols for all European universities. Additionally, it employs the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS).

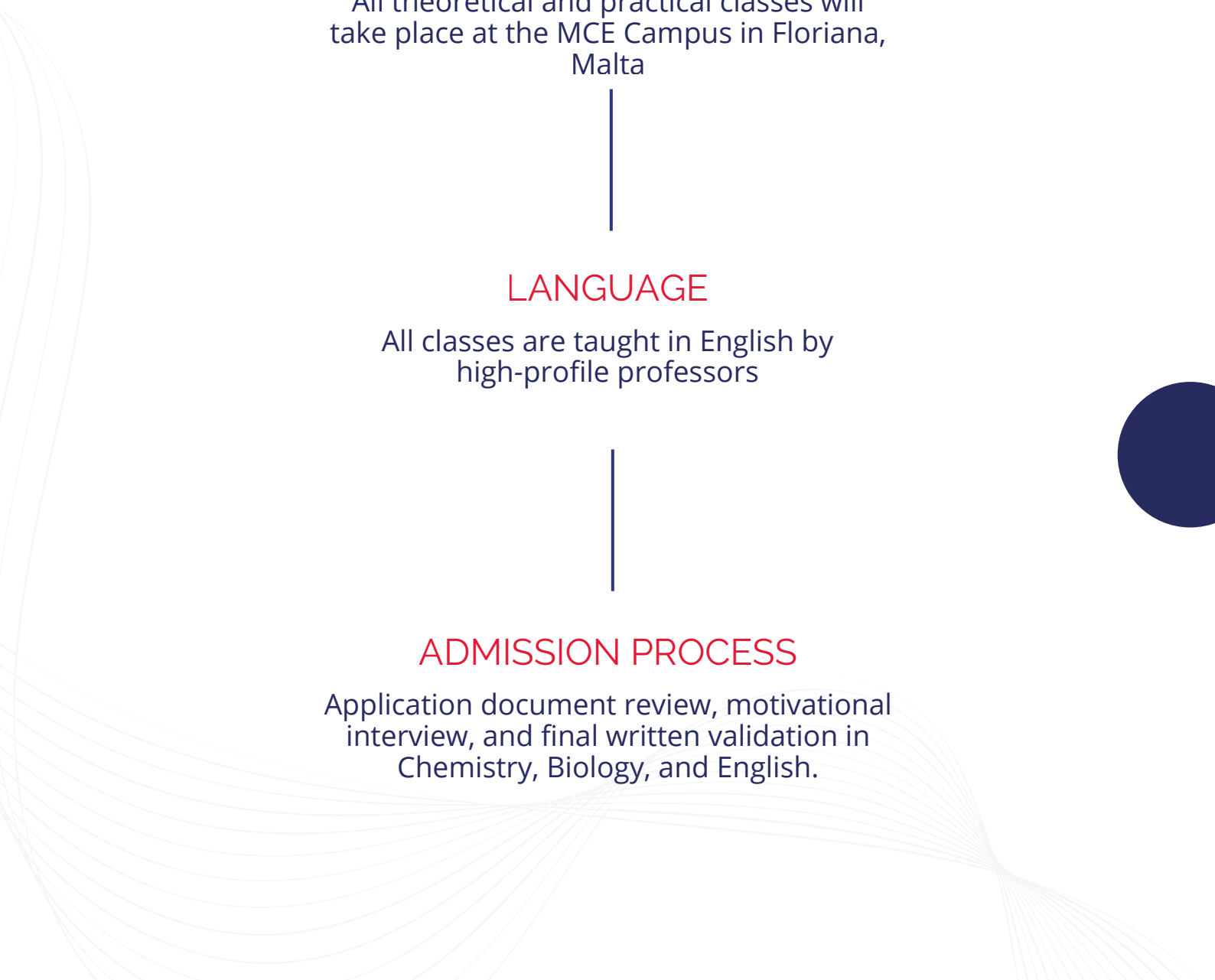

In Bulgaria, MCE has established a partnership with **UMBAL University Hospital “Prof. Dr. Stoyan Kirkovich”**, a multidisciplinary university hospital offering a broad range of medical, surgical and diagnostic specialties, where **MCE students can undertake clinical training from the 3rd academic year onwards.**

Its multidisciplinary setting gives students the opportunity to experience different areas of medical practice and understand how different specialties work together in the diagnosis, treatment and management of patients.

MCE has established a partnership with the **Ecclesiastic Order of the Brothers of Saint John of God (Brothers of Mercy)** to provide clinical internships at their University Hospital in Bratislava (Slovakia), part of one of the largest church-run hospital networks in the world.

With a medical tradition spanning centuries, the Order combines **professional healthcare with a strong commitment to patient-centred and compassionate care**. Its international network of hospitals and healthcare institutions provides a clinical environment shaped by extensive experience in medicine, education and assistance to patients.



Saint Michael's University Hospital

MCE also collaborates with **Saint Michael's University Hospital** in Bratislava, one of Slovakia's **modern and technologically advanced medical institutions**.

The hospital combines contemporary healthcare facilities, **advanced medical technologies and a wide range of specialised clinical services**, providing students with the opportunity to experience medicine in a modern and dynamic hospital environment.

An expanding international clinical network

MCE continues to expand its network of partner hospitals, with additional international internship opportunities being developed with university hospitals in **Italy, Germany and the Czech Republic**, including Prague and Brno.

Through this growing network, MCE aims to expose future doctors to different healthcare environments, medical specialties and approaches to patient care, adding an international dimension to their clinical education.

Early Clinical Exposure at Saint James Hospital Malta

From the 1st academic year, MCE students can have the opportunity to gain **non-curricular, on a voluntary basis, clinical exposure at Saint James Hospital in Malta**, complementing their academic studies with an early introduction to the hospital environment.

This early exposure helps students progressively develop professional awareness, confidence and a deeper understanding of the responsibilities involved in patient care, creating an important bridge between academic learning and their future clinical training.

MCE CAMPUS

The MCE Campus is located in the historic and well-known building “Casa Leone” in Floriana, just 800 meters from the capital, Valletta.

The MCE Campus covers a total area of approximately 1,300 square meters, spread over 5 floors, and offers welcoming and spacious facilities. In addition, a panoramic sea-view terrace is located on the rooftop.

LABORATORIES & PRACTICAL TRAINING

At MediCampus Europeo, theory and practice go hand in hand. Our modern laboratories provide students with a safe, advanced, and collaborative environment where they can explore the foundations of Human Biology, Anatomy, Chemistry, Physics, and all the medical sciences.



Equipped with high-precision microscopes, anatomical models, and cutting-edge technology, each laboratory has been designed to stimulate curiosity and support an interactive learning experience. Students work in small groups under the supervision of qualified lecturers, gaining the confidence and technical skills needed for clinical practice.

From the first year of the Degree Program, every student has the opportunity to perform guided experiments and laboratory sessions that bridge classroom learning with real-world medical applications.

MCE SUMMER DISSECTION WORKSHOP

MCE offers students the opportunity to take part in the **MCE Summer Dissection Workshop**, an **immersive hands-on experience designed to deepen the study of human anatomy through real cadaver dissection.**

Under the guidance of experienced anatomy professors, students can move beyond textbooks, digital models and traditional laboratory activities to observe and explore the human body directly. Through dissection, they are able to identify anatomical structures, understand their spatial relationships and connect theoretical concepts with real human anatomy.

The workshop is designed to strengthen students' knowledge while developing important practical skills such as anatomical orientation, precision, observation and dissection techniques. Working directly with cadaveric specimens also helps students build a more advanced three-dimensional understanding of organs, tissues, muscles, vessels and anatomical regions.

This type of experience can be especially valuable for future clinical and surgical training, as it helps students better understand how anatomical structures relate to one another in a real human body rather than only through diagrams or models.

More than an additional summer activity, the **MCE Summer Dissection Workshop** represents an opportunity to approach anatomy in a deeper, more practical and memorable way, reinforcing one of the fundamental foundations of medical education through direct experience.

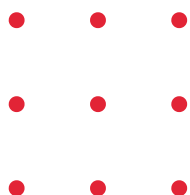


VALLETTA

TUITION & LIVING COSTS

TUITION FEES

- €14,500/year – single installment (to be paid in September).
- €15,500/year – two semester installments (to be paid in September and in January).
- €500 Enrollment Fee (one-time fee, applicable only in the 1st year).

LIVING IN MALTA

- Average monthly cost: €800–€1,000 (accommodation, food, daily expenses).
- Affordable lifestyle in a safe, welcoming, student-friendly country.





APPLICATION PROCESS OVERVIEW

Applying to MediCampus Europeo - Faculty of Medicine in Malta is simple, transparent, and fully accessible online.

1. Online Application

Complete the online application form and submit your academic documents.

2. MCE Admission Assessment

A short online session (approx. 1 hour) including:

- Review of academic documentation
- Motivational interview

3. Conditional Offer

Applicants who successfully complete the Admission Assessment may receive a Conditional Offer of Admission.

4. Final Academic Validation

A formal academic validation conducted by the awarding university, Trakia University, confirming fundamental knowledge in:

- English (native speakers exempt)
- Biology
- Chemistry

5. Final Acceptance & Enrollment

Upon successful completion of the Academic Validation, applicants receive a Final Acceptance Letter and proceed with enrolment.
