This Cookie Policy explains how Ransons of Ruthin Ltd ("we", "us", "our") uses cookies and similar technologies on rorescapes.com (the "Site"). It should be read alongside our Privacy Policy.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They help the site work properly, keep it secure, and remember your preferences. Similar technologies — such as pixels and local storage — work in much the same way, and references to "cookies" in this policy include these.

Some cookies are set by us or the services that run our Site ("first-party" cookies), and some are set by other organisations whose content appears on our Site, such as an embedded map ("third-party" cookies). Cookies may last only for your current visit ("session" cookies) or remain on your device for a set period ("persistent" cookies).

Your consent

When you first visit the Site, our cookie banner lets you accept or reject non-essential cookies. Strictly necessary cookies do not require your consent and are always active, because the Site cannot work properly without them. You can change or withdraw your choice at any time using the cookie settings link in the Site footer, or by clearing cookies in your browser settings.

The cookies we use

Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential for the Site to load, stay secure, and function correctly. They are always active and do not require consent. In particular, our Site is delivered and protected by Cloudflare, the content-delivery and security provider that hosts our Webflow-built site. Cloudflare sets a cookie called `_cfuvid`, which helps it tell individual visitors apart when several people share the same network, so its security and rate-limiting protections work fairly. This cookie lasts only for your browsing session, does not identify you personally, and is not used to track you across other websites.

Functional cookies

Our website platform may set limited cookies to keep interactive features of the Site working. These are not used for advertising or to track you across other sites.

Map cookies (third party)

If you choose to view an embedded Google Map on the Site, Google may set cookies in order to deliver the map and remember your map preferences. These cookies are non-essential and are only set after you have given your consent through our cookie banner. You can find out more about how Google uses cookies at policies.google.com/technologies/cookies.

Analytics cookies

We use Google Analytics to understand how visitors find and use our Site, so we can improve it. These cookies (such as `_ga` and `_ga_<id>`) are only set after you consent via our cookie banner. They help us count visits and see which pages are popular; they do not identify you personally. You can opt out at any time via our cookie settings. How to manage cookies

You can control cookies in several ways:

Our cookie banner and settings. Use the banner, or the cookie settings link in the Site footer, to accept or reject non-essential cookies and to change your choice at any time.

Your browser. Most browsers let you block or delete cookies through their settings. Please note that blocking strictly necessary cookies may stop parts of the Site from working. General guidance is available at www.aboutcookies.org and www.allaboutcookies.org.
