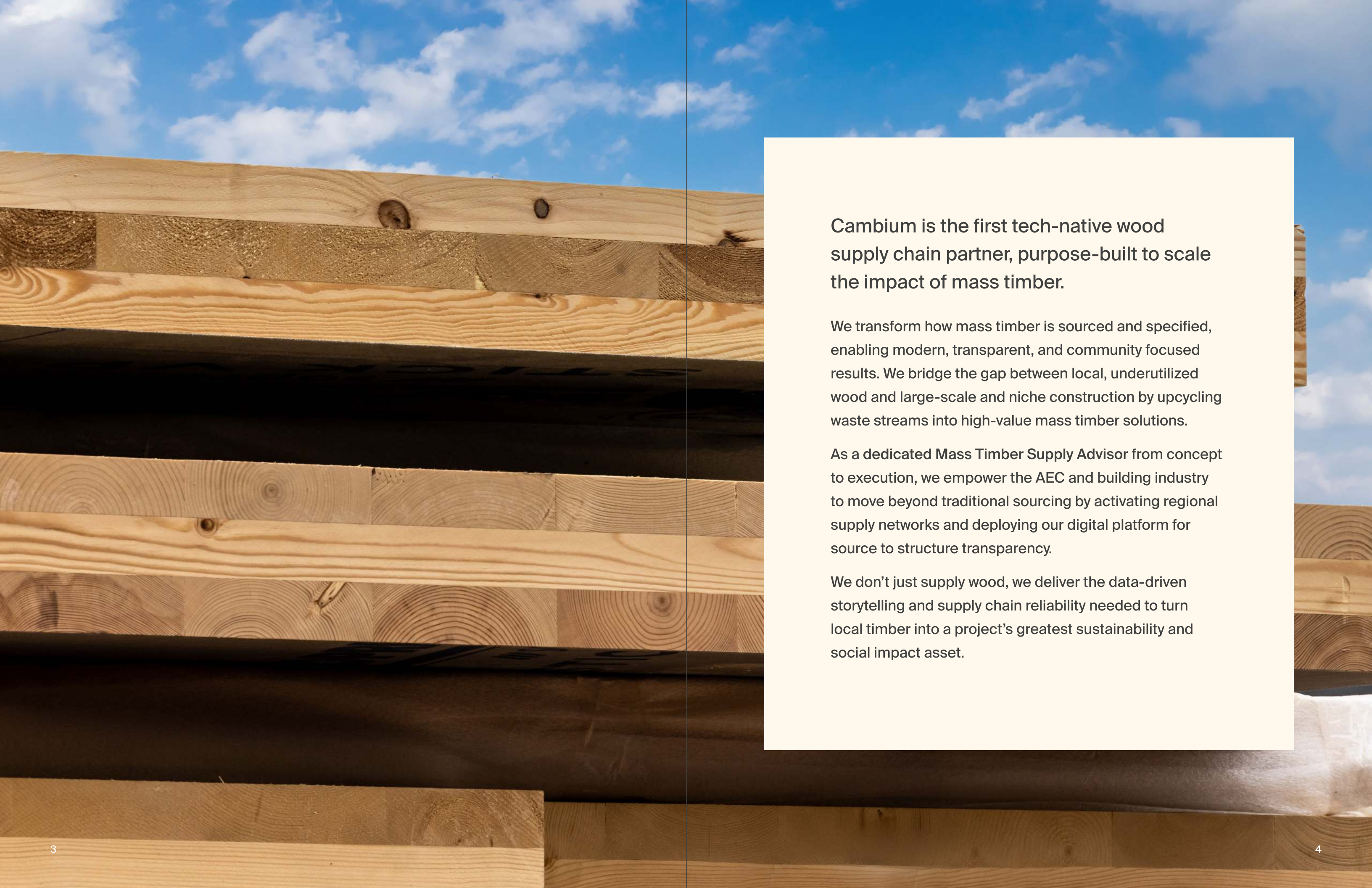
About Us

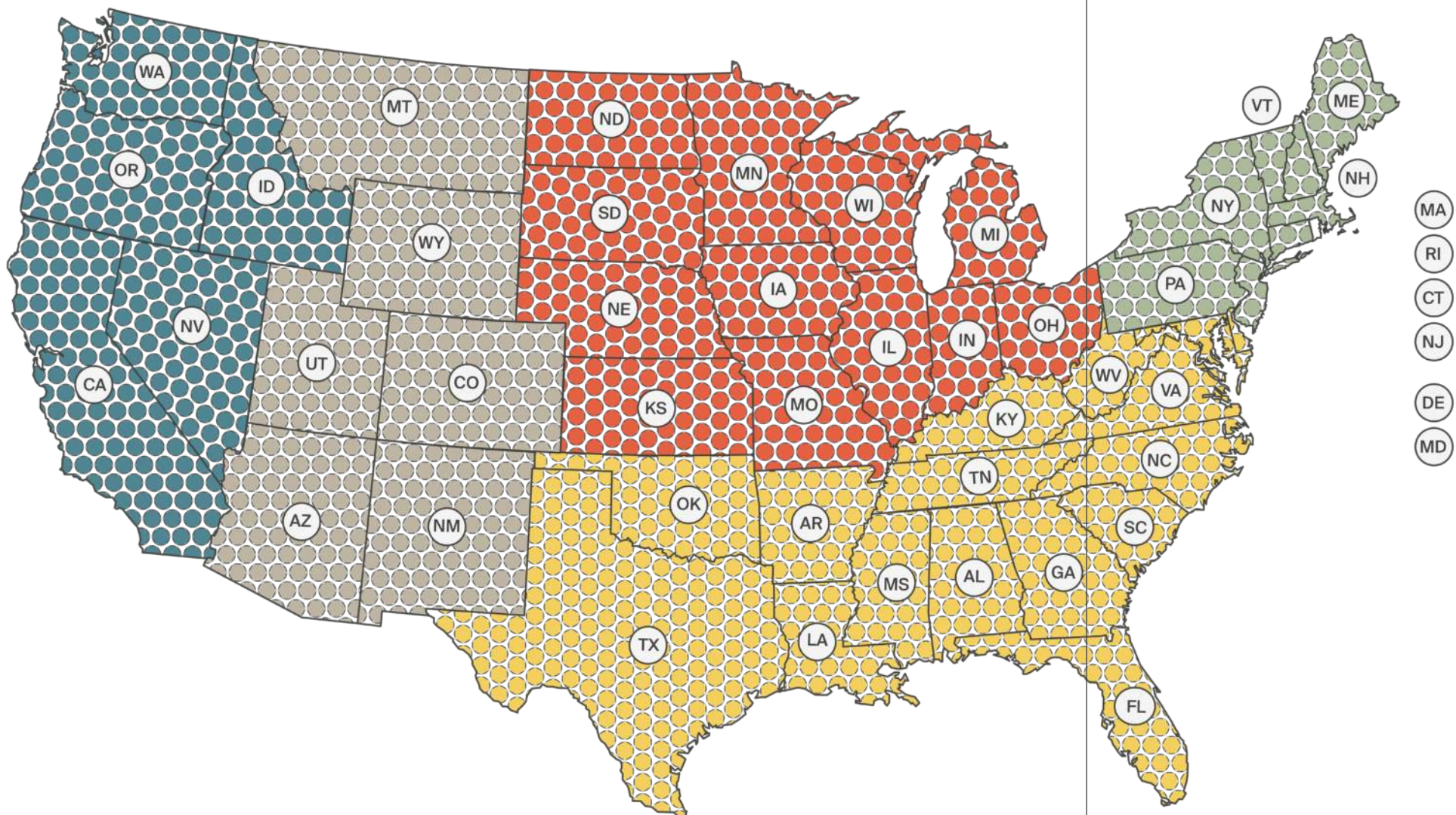

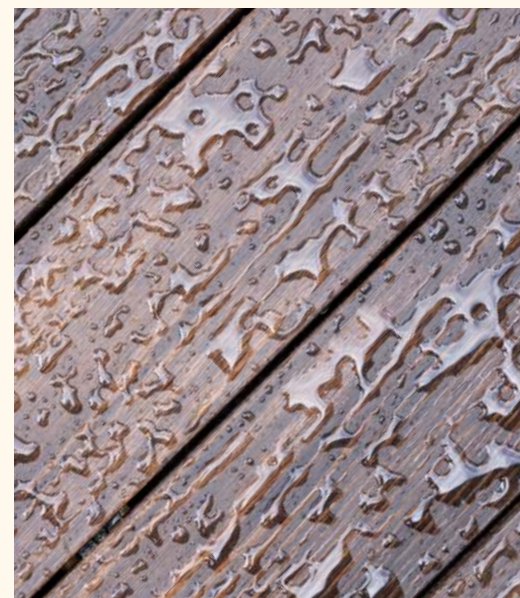
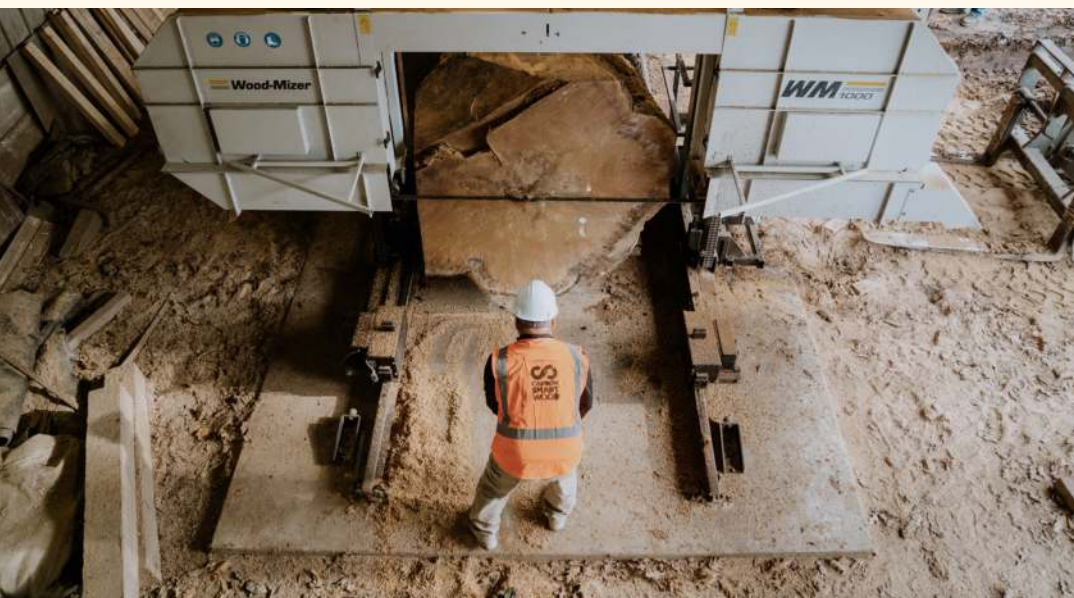

The Cambium Campfire

International Mass Timber Conference
March 2025

Campfire is a spiraling timber coil installation designed by RIOS in collaboration with Cambium, Sterling Structural, and Minimal Impact Engineering. The structure consists of interconnected A-frames reaching up to 28 feet, built from CNC-cut CLT panels measuring 15' x 8' — comprised of salvaged Southern Yellow Pine, Spruce Pine Fir South, and Eastern White Pine.

The art installation was purpose-built to demonstrate what's possible when salvaged wood enters a mass timber supply chain and is traced. The result is a structure that performs architecturally and tells a complete sustainability story — from source to structure.

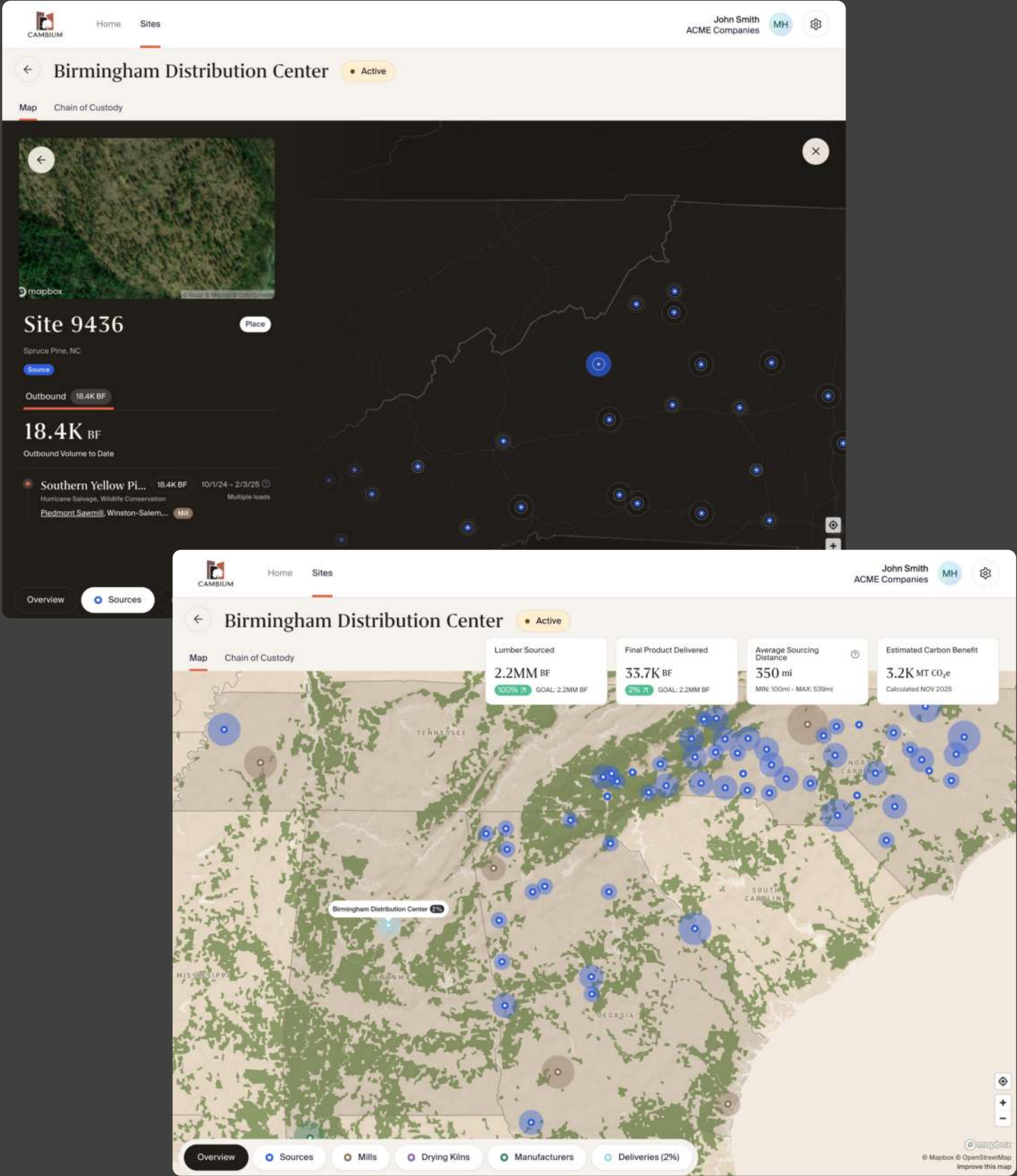
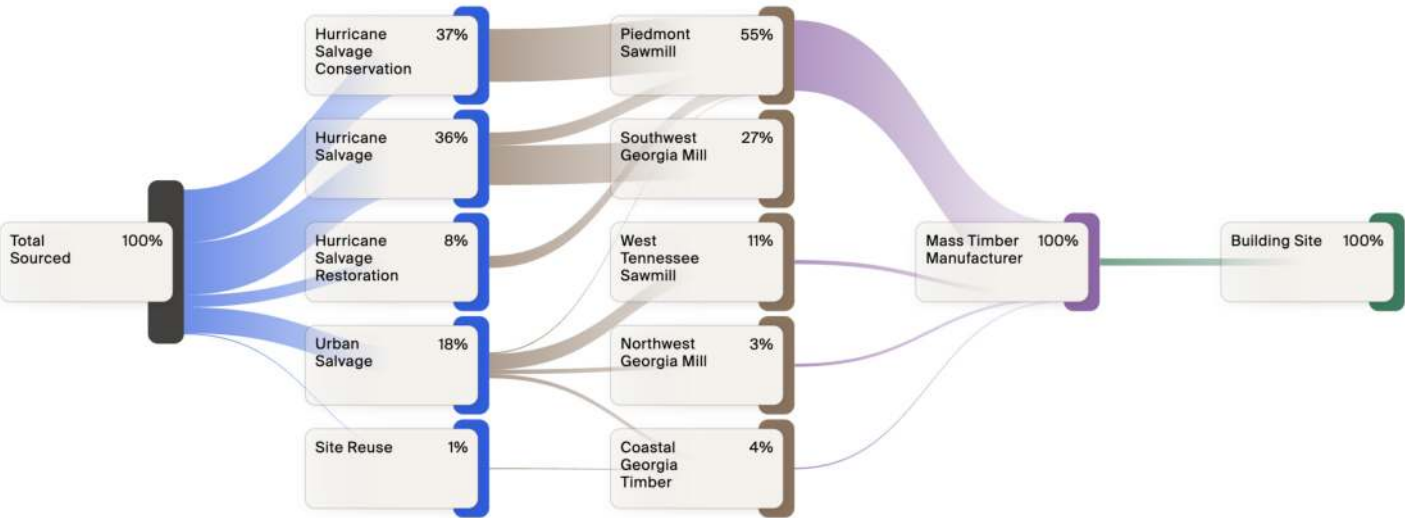

CASE STUDY

Annual Impacts of Carbon Smart Wood Utilized for Mass Timber in the Southeast

SOCIOECONOMIC

Carbon Smart Wood supply chains support community-based programs and local innovation by scaling nonprofit wood upcycling initiatives and reinvesting in regional sawmill technology and workforce development.¹

ENVIRONMENTAL

Salvaging storm-damaged and urban trees can reduce wildfire risk, limit pest outbreaks, support watershed health, and lower greenhouse gas emissions by diverting usable wood from waste streams into long-lived products.²

1. Estimates are based on an economic impact analysis of Carbon Smart Wood™ using a southeastern U.S. softwood lumber supply chain for CLT. This reflects Cambium's sourcing assumptions and partners as of September 2025.
