

Cookies Policy

1. Introduction

This Cookies Policy explains how WEB3 Technology B.V. ("WEB3 Technology", "we", "our" or "us") uses cookies and similar technologies on the website available at rgltd.com (the "Website").

We are committed to providing transparent information about the technologies used on the Website, the purposes for which they are used and the choices available to users.

This Policy should be read together with our Privacy Policy, which explains how we process personal data. Where cookies or similar technologies involve the processing of personal data, such processing is carried out in accordance with the Privacy Policy.

2. What are cookies and similar technologies?

Cookies are small text files stored on a user's device when visiting a website.

In addition to cookies, websites may use similar technologies that store information on or access information from a user's device or browser, including local storage, session storage and IndexedDB technologies.

For the purposes of this Policy, references to cookies include such similar technologies unless otherwise stated.

Cookies and similar technologies may be stored only for the duration of a browsing session or for a longer period, depending on their purpose and configuration.

3. Why do we use cookies and similar technologies?

We use cookies and similar technologies to:

- ensure the proper operation, security and availability of the Website,
- remember user preferences and consent choices,
- protect the Website and its infrastructure against abuse, malicious activity and automated traffic,
- secure contact and communication forms against spam and bot activity,
- understand how visitors interact with the Website,
- measure Website performance and improve our services,
- support embedded third-party content,
- measure the effectiveness of communications and marketing activities.

4. Categories of cookies and similar technologies

Necessary

Necessary technologies are required for the operation, security and functionality of the Website.

They enable core Website functions, including security controls, protection against automated abuse, management of cookie preferences and access to essential Website features.

Because these technologies are strictly necessary for the provision, security and proper functioning of the Website, they do not require consent and cannot be disabled through the cookie preference centre.

Statistics

Statistics technologies help us understand how visitors use the Website by collecting information about Website usage, interactions and performance.

The information collected through these technologies is used to analyse Website performance, improve user experience and better understand how the Website is used.

Statistics technologies are activated only after the user has provided consent.

Marketing

Marketing technologies help us measure the effectiveness of communications and marketing activities, support embedded third-party content and better understand how users interact with such content.

When users interact with embedded YouTube content, YouTube and Google may place cookies and similar technologies on the user's device and collect information about the use of such content.

Marketing technologies are activated only after the user has provided consent.

6. Consent and cookie preferences

Except for technologies that are strictly necessary for the operation, security and proper functioning of the Website, cookies and similar technologies are used only after the user has provided consent through the cookie preference centre.

Consent is obtained before any non-essential technologies are placed on or accessed from the user's device.

Necessary cookies and similar technologies are used to ensure the security, integrity and proper functioning of the Website and fall within the exemption applicable to strictly necessary technologies under applicable law.

Refusing consent for statistics or marketing technologies will not affect the user's ability to access or use the Website.

Users may grant, refuse or withdraw consent at any time and may modify their preferences through the cookie preference centre.

Users may review, modify or withdraw their consent preferences at any time through the cookie preference centre accessible via the "Cookie Settings" link available on the Website.

Withdrawal or modification of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out before such withdrawal or modification.

7. Managing cookies

Most web browsers automatically accept cookies and similar technologies.

Users may configure browser settings at any time to block, restrict or delete technologies stored on their devices.

Information on how to manage cookies is usually available in the browser's help section. Available options may vary depending on the browser and device used.

Please note that disabling technologies necessary for the operation and security of the Website may affect the availability or proper functioning of certain Website features, including contact forms and security mechanisms.
