1. Introduction

1.1 AMUN CONSULTING LTD, a company incorporated under the laws of the British Virgin Islands (the "**Company**," "**we**," "**our**," or "**us**"), is committed to protecting the privacy of individuals whose personal data we process. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your personal data when you visit the website located at <https://www.amun.consulting> (the "**Website**").

1.2 For the purposes of applicable data protection legislation, the data controller is AMUN CONSULTING LTD, having its registered office at Intershore Chambers, P.O. Box 4342, Road Town, Tortola, British Virgin Islands, contactable at business@amun.consulting.

1.3 By using the Website, you acknowledge that you have read and understood this Privacy Policy.

2. Personal Data We Collect

2.1 **Information you provide to us.** This may include your name, email address, telephone number (where provided), and any other information you submit through our contact forms or by email.

2.2 **Information collected automatically.** When you access the Website, we may automatically collect your IP address, browser type and version, the pages you visit and time spent on the Website, referral sources, and device information (such as operating system and screen resolution). This information is collected by means of cookies and analytics tools, as further described in our Cookies Notice.

3. Purposes of Processing

We process personal data for the following purposes: (a) to provide and improve our consulting services; (b) to respond to inquiries and provide support; (c) to analyze website traffic and improve the user experience; and (d) to comply with our legal and regulatory obligations.

We do **not** sell, rent, or trade your personal data.

4. Legal Bases for Processing

Where data protection legislation (including the EU/UK General Data Protection Regulation) applies to you, we rely on the following legal bases: (a) **Consent** — where you have given your consent (for example, to non-essential cookies or marketing communications); (b) **Legitimate interests** — to respond to inquiries, to operate and improve the Website, and to conduct our business, provided such interests are not overridden by your rights and freedoms; (c) **Performance of a contract** — where processing is necessary to provide

services you have requested; and (d) **Legal obligation** — where processing is necessary for compliance with applicable law.

5. Disclosure of Personal Data

5.1 We may disclose your personal data to: (a) third-party service providers (such as analytics and hosting providers); (b) providers within our trusted network, where you have requested a service delivered by such a provider, and only to the extent necessary to facilitate that service; and (c) competent legal or regulatory authorities, where required by applicable law.

5.2 We require all such third parties to process personal data in accordance with applicable data protection obligations.

6. International Transfers of Personal Data

6.1 We operate from the British Virgin Islands, maintain a mailing address in Intershore Chambers, P.O. Box 4342, Road Town, Tortola, British Virgin Islands, and engage providers that may be located in various jurisdictions. Accordingly, your personal data may be transferred to, and processed in, countries other than your own, including countries outside the European Economic Area (the "**EEA**").

6.2 Where such transfers occur, we rely on appropriate safeguards designed to ensure an adequate level of protection for your personal data, including, where applicable, the European Commission's Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs) or transfers to jurisdictions recognized as providing an adequate level of protection under an applicable adequacy decision. You may request further information regarding the safeguards applied by contacting us at business@amun.consulting.

7. Data Retention

We retain personal data only for as long as is necessary to fulfil the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy, or for such longer period as may be required by applicable law. In particular: (a) **Inquiry and contact data** — personal data submitted through our contact forms or by email is retained for up to twenty-four (24) months following our last interaction with you, unless you request earlier deletion; (b) **Client and contractual data** — personal data relating to a client engagement is retained for the duration of the business relationship and for a period of seven (7) years thereafter, in order to comply with applicable accounting, tax, and legal obligations; and (c) **Analytics data** — data collected through analytics tools is retained in accordance with the retention settings of the relevant tool (for example, Google Analytics data is typically retained for up to fourteen (14) months).

Upon expiry of the applicable retention period, personal data is securely deleted or anonymized.

8. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We use cookies and similar tracking technologies to enhance your experience. Non-essential cookies are set only after you have provided your consent. Further details are set out in our Cookies Notice. You may manage your preferences through your browser settings and through our cookie consent banner.

9. Data Security

We implement appropriate technical and organizational measures designed to protect your personal data. However, no method of transmission or storage is entirely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security. If you believe your personal data has been compromised, please contact us immediately at business@amun.consulting.

10. Your Rights

Subject to applicable law, you may have the following rights in respect of your personal data: (a) **Access** — to obtain a copy of your personal data; (b) **Rectification** — to request the correction of inaccurate data; (c) **Erasure** — to request the deletion of your personal data; (d) **Objection** — to object to processing for direct marketing purposes; (e) **Restriction** — to request that we restrict processing in certain circumstances; (f) **Portability** — to receive your personal data in a structured, commonly used format; (g) **Withdrawal of consent** — to withdraw your consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing carried out prior to such withdrawal; and (h) **Complaint** — to lodge a complaint with your local data protection supervisory authority.
