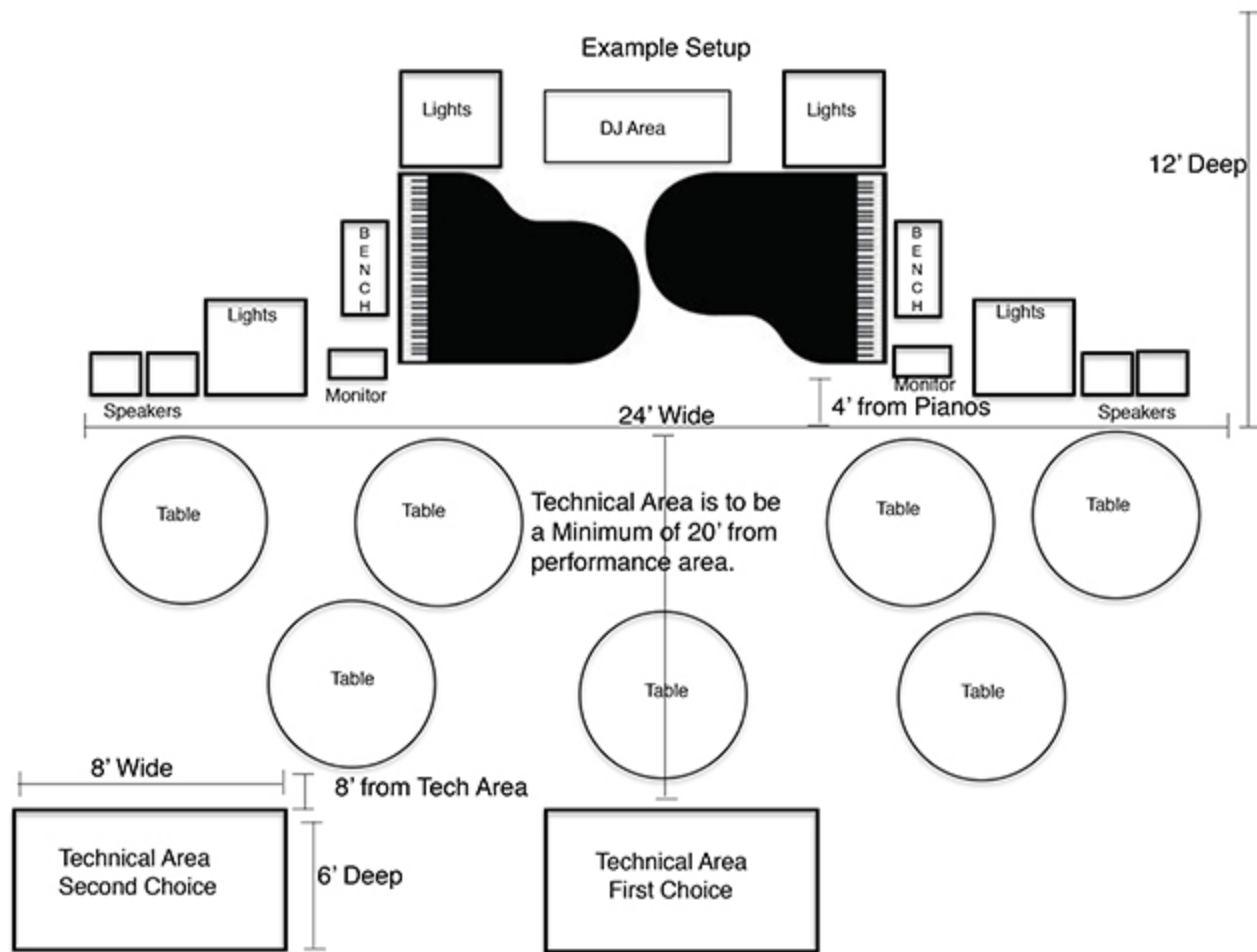
First of all, thank you for booking a show with Piano Fondue, LLC. Below is a list of our technical requirements. It might sound a bit formal to you; this is not meant to cause any inconveniences on your behalf. We designed this rider for optimum effectiveness for the day of the show. If there are any questions or if you have trouble providing any of the below mentioned please get in touch with our Technical Director Mikey Russell "mikey@pianofondue.com" forty-five (45) days prior to your show and workout a solution that will work out for all parties involved.

- **ARRIVAL**

- Please provide us with detailed instructions, two weeks prior to the event, with Venue Contact and load-in area details.
- We need a safe parking space for our truck and trailer close to the venue once it is unloaded.

- **PERFORMANCE / TECHNICAL AREA**

- Performance Area
 - Size needs to be no less than 24' in length and 12' in depth
 - Once **Piano Fondue** is set up, tables can be placed within 4' of pianos.
 - Please make sure there are still aisles for people to walk up to the pianos
 - Pitcher(s) of water with cups/glasses placed on stage prior to performance
- Technical area
 - The technical area needs to be no less than 6' in length and 6' in depth.
 - Should be a minimum of 20' from the performance area and no more than 80'
 - **Piano Fondue** recommends tables not be placed within 4' of the Technical area.
 - Pitcher(s) of water with cups/glasses placed near the Technical area prior to performance



- **POWER**
 - *Minimum* of one (1) 120V/20A grounded AC circuit must be located near the performance space. Two (2) available circuits is preferred.
 - These circuits are to be used solely for **Piano Fondue's** equipment.
 - One (1) 120V/20A grounded AC circuit located near Technical Area.
 - This circuit is to be used solely for **Piano Fondue's** equipment.
- **Wi-Fi**
 - **Piano Fondue's** entertainers use the internet to find song lyrics and notes for the songs that are being requested from time to time.
 - If the venue has a password protected Wi-Fi, please inform engineers password upon their or your arrival.
- **SET-UP & SOUND CHECK**
 - **Piano Fondue** will only use their equipment, including sound and lighting systems, unless mutually agreed upon in advance.
 - **Piano Fondue** requires up to 3 hours for set up prior to guest arrival.
 - **Piano Fondue** requires 30 minutes for our sound check prior to guest arrival.
 - Sound Check should be scheduled such that no other events are taking place simultaneously near the room/space we are performing in and will occur after the performance area has been set.
- **STORAGE**
 - **Piano Fondue** will need a room / area to store cases out of sight in the venue.
- **CHANGES**
 - Any changes made to the above list may not be modified without written approval from **Piano Fondue**.
 - **Piano Fondue** IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR CANCELLATION DUE TO UNAUTHORIZED CHANGES OF THE TERMS OF THIS RIDER.

Failure to follow items outlined in this rider may cause **Piano Fondue** to withhold services, unless changes are agreed upon prior to contract signing.

Full payment will still be required and no refund will be given.

Once this form and the Performance Agreement are signed, the Contract between **Piano Fondue** and the **Client** will be considered booked and binding.
