## Robert Booth Pavilion Underway

I am pleased to provide this community matters update with so much happening in Narre Warren South.

Work continues on the delivery of the Robert Booth Reserve pavilion, Hampton Park Tennis Club lighting, resurfacing and pavilion upgrade, as well as Strathaird Recreation Reserve pavilion refurbishment and Hampton Park Bowls pavilion renovation.

Not to mention the Webb Street Level Crossing Removal and support for our schools and community groups.

The Robert Booth Reserve pavilion upgrade is well underway thanks to the Andrews Labor Government's \$3 million investment.

The brand new pavilion will ensure that Hampton Park Football Netball Club and Hampton Park Cricket Club have the best facilities for their players, supporters and spectators.

Recently, the first-floor slab, roof, brickworks, windows and doors, and concrete stairs were completed.

The next stage will see the lift, internal services, plaster works and external paving slab installed.

City of Casey is supporting the delivery of the Robert Booth Reserve project along with other State Government investments in the area.

Local construction is providing jobs and state-of-the-art facilities which will encourage more people to get active and foster the next generation of talent.

# Lyndhurst Secondary College

## PLANNING UNDERWAY

Plans are underway for the upgrade of Lyndhurst Secondary College. Principal Eloise Haynes is looking forward to the enhanced facilities for students, staff and teachers.

The school and local community will benefit from modern learning spaces that encourage engagement and the best education possible.

The Andrews Labor Government has invested more than \$14.9 billion in building and upgrading schools in every corner of the state.

The State Government is building 100 new schools by 2026, with 84 already funded or opened and more than 1,940 upgrades delivered, creating more than 21,200 jobs in construction and associated industries.



## Works update at Hampton Park Bowls Club

Works are commencing in July on an upgraded pavilion for Hampton Park Bowls Club.

The Andrews Labor Government has provided \$530,000 towards the upgrade with the tender awarded and the procurement process underway.

Council officers are now working with President Mark Paton and the Club on the construction planning.

The redevelopment will deliver an extension of the social area and servery, construction of a new kitchen, office and meeting space, equipment storage areas and two canopies will provide further shade during those long hot bowling sessions.

These works will support current players, families and spectators and encourage more people to get involved.



## Le Mana Pasifika Engaging Youth

The State Budget 2023/24 provides \$1.53 million for the Le Mana Pasifika project as it delivers support for over 2,000 Pasifika youth with activities and events to promote education and youth engagement.

The organisation helps young people develop a strong sense of identity through mentorship programs, cultural events and pride in their Pasifika heritage.

It was great to attend a late night hoops session with Lee Tarlamis MP and hear from Tamese Leilua about how the organisation connects to resources and networks that empower young people.

## **Grices Rd Recreation Reserve Pavilion Upgrade**

The Andrews Labor Government has announced \$1.2 million in the State Budget 2023/24 towards the upgrade of the pavilion at Grices Road Recreation Reserve which is home to various clubs including Berwick Churches Soccer Club.

Michael Galea MP and I were pleased to announce the upgrade as part of the State Budget's \$201.2 million investment for community sport and active recreation infrastructure across the State.

The upgraded pavilion will provide club members and the community with greater access to essential facilities while improving the experience for players and supporters.

Since 2014, the Andrews Labor Government has invested more than \$1.6 billion state-wide to upgrade and improve recreation reserves and sports grounds, making them better for local families.

## **Thompsons Road Upgrade**

The State Budget 2023/24 announced \$70 million to upgrade the intersection at Thompsons Road and Berwick-Cranbourne Road.

This funding is part of a road blitz to get families home sooner and safer.

The new intersection will improve traffic flow, safety and reduce bottlenecks.

The Andrews Labor Government will continue to invest in our roads, level crossing removals, public transport, and rail network to keep everyone moving.

Indeed, the Metro Tunnel is set to open in 2025, a year ahead of schedule and will be connected to the Pakenham Line.

## **Women's Health Clinic**

The Andrews Labor Government announced almost \$58 million in the State Budget 2023/24 to deliver 20 new comprehensive women's health clinics across Victoria including one at Casey Hospital.

The clinic will be a one-stop-shop for women needing treatment from contraception to pelvic pain.

The State Government is also supporting the next generation of paramedics with funding to train and deploy 25 paramedic practitioners and an additional 40 mobile Intensive Care Ambulance paramedics across Victoria.

## Webb Street Level Crossing Removal

Works at the Webb Street Level Crossing Removal are well underway with completion due by 2025. This is one of the 110 dangerous and congested crossings to go by 2030 with 70 removed so far.

## Hampton Park Uniting Church

Hampton Park Uniting Church will receive \$50,000 to support its ongoing efforts in providing assistance to the most vulnerable members of our community.

## Strathaird Recreation Reserve

The State Government has invested \$1.5 million towards the refurbishment of facilities at Strathaird Recreation Reserve which will provide Narre Warren South Cricket, Football, and Netball Clubs with upgraded facilities.

## Casey Radio

Casey Radio has been an institution for the local area and the State Budget 2023/24 provides \$50,000 to support their work in the creative industries as a station that trains and gives opportunities to so many in radio while providing entertainment to Casey.

## Hampton Park Tennis Club

New courts, lighting and a \$550,000 upgraded pavilion are on the way at Hampton Park Tennis Club.

Thanks to State Government funding and support from City of Casey, players and spectators will be enjoying new court surfaces, lighting and facilities that ensure our community stays active and connected.
