## How We Serve Our Community

- Protects people and property across **100 square miles** in Weld and Larimer Counties
- Operates out of **4 strategically placed stations** throughout our service area
- Powered by **65 highly trained first responders** and critical support staff

## Rising Demand, Costs, and Wildfire Risk

- Demand for services, and the associated costs, are growing faster than available funding.
- WSFR must address its staffing levels, aging equipment, and inadequate stations to maintain quality service.



**Calls for service have increased 29% in 5 years.**



**A new fire engine now costs \$1.2 million – a 118% increase in 5 years.**



**27 new firefighters are needed over 10 years.**

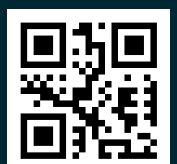
## A Budget Deficit is Looming

## The Proposal Under Consideration

The Board of Directors is considering a **phased mill levy** increase – a total of 4 mills over 10 years to help **spread out the cost**.



This will ensure WSFR can **meet minimum staffing requirements** set by the National Fire Protection Association.



Even with a 4-mill increase, WSFR will **still have one of the lowest rates in the state** based on assessed values.

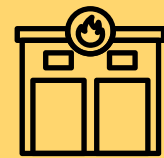
## What We Would Do With the Additional Funds



**Add 27 new firefighters and 6 essential administrative staff over 10 years**



**Replace aging emergency apparatus like fire engines**



**Build a fifth station to meet National Fire Protection Association response time benchmarks**
