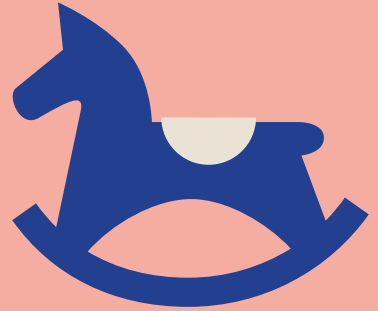

Pathways & Further Study

After completing the Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care, students may gain employment as a Child Care Worker, Kindergarten or Preschool Assistant, Primary School Teacher Aide, or may choose to go onto further study such as the Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care, Advanced diploma of Children's Services or gain credit towards a university degree such as Bachelor of Education (Early Childhood).

Course Requirements

To be awarded a Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care, competency must be achieved in eighteen (18) units of competency.
