Application

SURFATA[®] AG 5020 emulsifier and emulsion stabilizer for concentrated (oil-in-water) emulsions (EW) as well as a stabilizer in suspoemulsions. Effective use in concentrated O/W emulsions is in conjunction with **SURFATA[®] AG 5000**. As a dispersant it can be used in systems of low and medium polarity.

Mode of Action

Due to its multiple anchoring groups, **SURFATA[®] AG 5020** promotes a highly stable emulsion through the construction of a very efficient steric barrier against re-agglomeration and coagulation. Due its greater anchorage, it can be used in concentrations up to five times lower than traditional emulsifiers.
