COOKIES POLICY

ADARA VENTURES, SGEIC, S.A.

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1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The following policy provides the User with general information about what cookies are used and what types of cookies exist.

What are Cookies?

Cookies and other similar devices, such as pixels, web bugs, etc. are text or image files that are installed in the user's browser when the user accesses an online service. Cookies allow, among other things, to store and retrieve information about the user, their browser, their devices and the user's activity in the service they are connecting to.

2. TYPES OF COOKIES

There are many types of cookies. Below, we offer the user some classifications of them, without necessarily implying that this service uses all these types of cookies:

2.1 By Entity Managing Cookies

- Own cookies: are those that are sent to the user's device or terminal from the equipment or domain belonging to the owner of a service and managed by the latter.
- Third-party cookies: are those that are sent to the user's device or terminal from a computer or domain that is not managed by the owner of a service, but by a third party that will process the information obtained through cookies.

2.2 By Retention Period

- Session Cookies: are those that collect and store data when the user accesses a service and cease once the user leaves it.
- Persistent Cookies: are those that have a duration determined in time by the person responsible for the service. The conservation time can vary from a few minutes to several years.

2.3 By Purpose

- Technical Cookies: essential and strictly necessary for the proper functioning of the service.
- Personalization Cookies: allow the user to customize features of a service such as language, regional configuration or browser type.
- Analytical Cookies: allow counting unique visitors and analysing the use of a service to measure its interest.

- Advertising Cookies: allow the management of advertising space in a service.
- Behavioral Advertising Cookies: store information on user behavior in order to display personalised advertising.

2.4 Other Technologies

- Pixels / web bugs / trackers: tiny transparent 1x1 images inserted into a service to measure activity and track user IP routes.
- HTML5 storage: stores parameters in the user's browser using HTML5 technology to identify it.
- Local Shared Objects (LSO): also known as 'flash cookies', stores information using Adobe Flash Player technology.
- Etags: an HTTP protocol mechanism that can be used to recognise the user's browser.
- Canvas fingerprinting generates a unique shape in the user's browser using HTML5 to identify the user's computer.
- Font detection: identifies the font configuration of the user's computer to obtain a unique identification.
- Browser cache: stores information in the browser cache to identify the user's device.
- WebGL: takes advantage of 3D rendering capabilities of modern browsers to obtain a unique identification of the computer.

3. SPECIFIC INFORMATION

3.1 Who Manages This Service?

This service is the responsibility of Adara Venture Partners III S.à.r.l. (hereinafter, 'ADARA'), a company incorporated in Luxembourg, established at 15 Boulevard F.W. Raiffeisen, Luxembourg, L-2411, registered with the Luxembourg Trade & Companies Register under number B 177954.

3.3 How to Disable or Delete Cookies?
