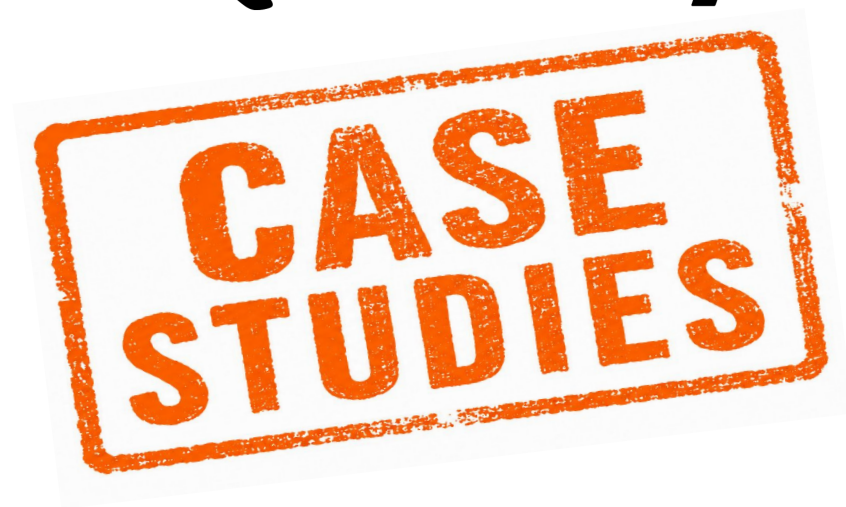

The Challenge

With approximately 3,400 covered lives, the organization was already using a vendor for pharmacy cost containment. But over the previous two years, pharmacy spend had been increasing approximately **15% per quarter**.

They needed to materially change the direction of their pharmacy spend.

The Rescrybe Approach

Rescrybe implemented a **specialty carve-out** focused on identifying the **lowest net-cost pathway** for eligible high-cost medications and continuously managing those opportunities as pricing and medication needs changed.

Rather than treating the pharmacy benefit as a static program, Rescrybe actively managed the population and adjusted the strategy over time.

64% Lower Pharmacy Spend After Moving Beyond the Traditional PBM Model

The Challenge

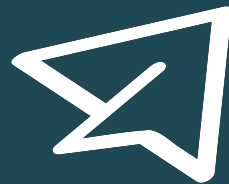
This self-funded education employer was relying on its existing “Big 3” PBM structure to manage specialty pharmacy costs. High-cost medications continued to put pressure on the plan, and the employer didn't have a strategy in place.

Their average pharmacy spend was: **\$159.37 Per Member Per Month**

The Rescrybe Approach

Rescrybe implemented a specialty carve-out to identify eligible high-cost medications and move them to lower net-cost pathways.

At the same time, Rescrybe managed the **member experience** around those transitions so savings opportunities could actually turn into completed prescription fills.

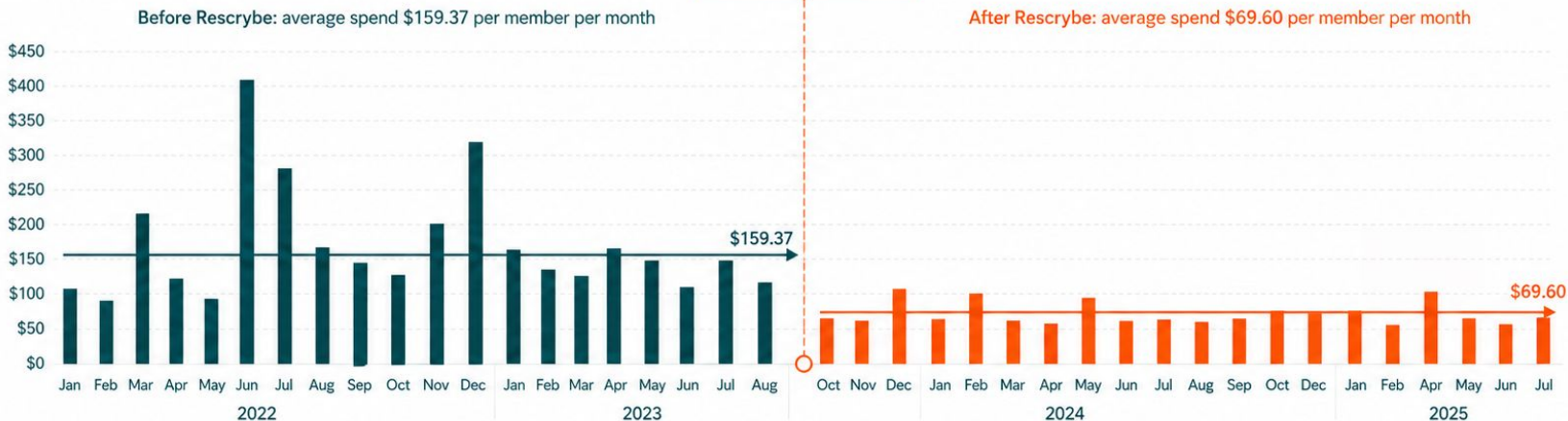

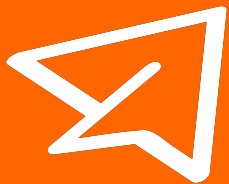

The Challenge

This employer had a cost containment program in place.

They understood the benefits, but they questioned if they were getting the best possible results from the program they had.

The Rescrybe Approach

Rescrybe evaluated medications being filled through the incumbent program and compared the incumbent cost directly against the **cost of those same medications** through Rescrybe.

This isn't a comparison built around different utilization assumptions or hypothetical savings. It is a like-for-like comparison of identical medications.

Lower Costs are More Impactful when Members Actually Use the Program

The Challenge

This employer already had a cost containment program, but savings potential only matters when eligible prescriptions successfully transition into the program.

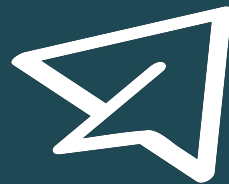
There were two opportunities:

- **Reduce medication cost**
- **Fill more eligible prescriptions through the program**

The Rescrybe Approach

Rescrybe combined lower medication pricing with proactive member support designed to help eligible employees successfully transition prescriptions **from retail to lower-cost pathways**.

Rescrybe supports the process through outreach, enrollment, prescription coordination, refills, and answers to questions.

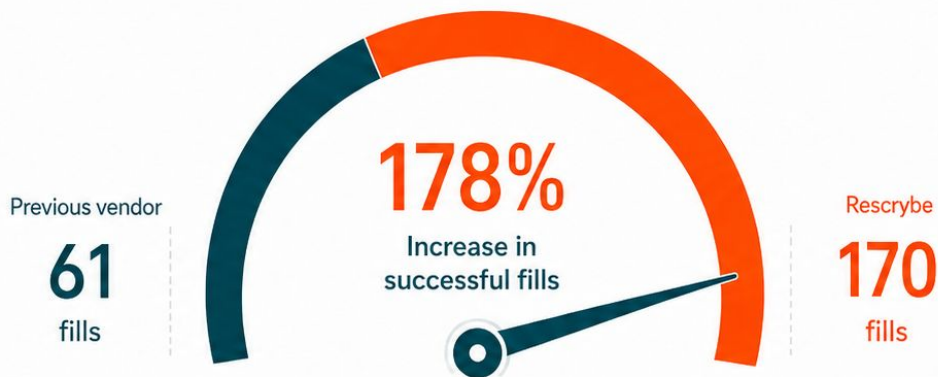
