- Be prepared for a quick and efficient response in case of a pollution incident.
- Consider Environment as a priority in our business decisions.
- Promote environmental-friendly technologies, materials, goods, and services within the company and towards our stakeholders.
- Bower Offshore will search continual improvement of the company's environmental objectives and will have a continuous focus on improved fuel efficiency and reduced emissions to air.
- Encourage employees' participation throughout the organization to identify where we may improve our practices and achieve our Environmental Goals.
- Maintain the ISO 14001:2015 certification.
