Gentek Reg MCP — Acceptable Use Policy

By creating an account or accessing the Gentek Reg MCP (the "Service"), you confirm that you have read and agree to this Policy and the Terms and Conditions, and that you accept them on behalf of yourself and, where you use the Service for an organisation, that organisation (which you confirm you have authority to bind).

This Policy applies together with the terms of Gentek.ai Limited ("Gentek", "we", "us" or "our"), including [our Terms and Conditions](#), [our Privacy Policy](#), [our Cookie Notice](#) and, where we process personal data on your behalf, [our Data Processing Agreement](#), each of which is incorporated by reference. Our Privacy Policy explains how we collect and use personal data (including any account or contact details you provide). Our Cookie Notice explains our use of cookies and similar technologies, for which consent is obtained through the Service interface where required.

1. What this Service is

The Service helps you look up and interpret regulatory reference data and validation rules from public sources, including ESMA FIRDS, the FCA's FIRDS and instrument reference data, and GLEIF LEI and Legal Entity Reference Data (the "**Source Providers**"). It uses automated and AI-based processing and is an **information tool only**, not the official source, not a filing system, and not legal, regulatory, financial or other professional advice. You remain solely responsible for your regulatory obligations and must verify any output against the relevant official source before relying on it. You acknowledge that you will not rely on any output for any regulatory filing, submission or decision without first independently verifying it against the relevant official source.

The Service is intended for business and professional use only. You may register and use the Service as an individual, including as an employee, consultant, sole trader or other professional, provided that you use the Service wholly or mainly for purposes connected with your business, trade, craft or profession and not as a consumer.

2. Third-party source data

Material accessed through the Service originates from the Source Providers and remains subject to their own terms, which you agree to observe. The licence basis and requirements for each Source Provider are set out below, and apply in addition to the general restrictions in this section.

In particular, you must not:

- Imply that any Source Provider endorses, is affiliated with, or supplies you, the Service or your products
- Make false or misleading statements about a Source Provider
- Use a Source Provider's name, trademark or logo without its prior written permission

Where you republish source-derived material, you must acknowledge the source and state if it has been altered. The underlying public data is available free of charge from the Source Providers, and data may have been normalised, enriched or combined with other sources by Gentek. You should refer to the relevant official source for definitive regulatory information.

2.1 FCA: UK FIRDS and instrument reference data

To the extent that FCA information used by the Service is made available under the [Open Government Licence v3.0](#), Gentek uses that information in accordance with it and acknowledges the source as follows: “Contains FCA information licensed under the Open Government Licence v3.0.”

The same information is available free of charge directly from the FCA, and the version provided through the Service may have been normalised, transformed, enriched or combined with other sources. The FCA does not endorse the Service, Gentek or any product or service offered through it.

FCA FIRDS also includes information sourced from ESMA, in which case the ESMA conditions in section 2.2 may also apply to that information.

2.2 ESMA: EU FIRDS

The Service uses information obtained from ESMA's website and registers. Original ESMA information may be obtained free of charge through ESMA's website.

Gentek acknowledges ESMA as the source of this information, which may have been normalised, transformed, enriched or combined with other sources. ESMA does not endorse Gentek, the Service or any product or service offered through it.

FCA FIRDS may also contain ESMA-sourced information, in which case the applicable ESMA conditions may continue to apply.

2.3 GLEIF: LEI and Legal Entity Reference Data

The Service uses GLEIF LEI and Legal Entity Reference Data, which GLEIF makes available in the public domain under a Creative Commons Zero (CC0) dedication. Gentek acknowledges GLEIF as the source of this information, which may have been normalised, transformed, enriched or combined with other sources, and claims no proprietary rights in the original data.

GLEIF does not endorse Gentek, the Service or any product or service offered through it, and you must not imply that GLEIF supports, authorises or is otherwise associated with the Service. The data is provided "as is" without any warranty as to its accuracy or completeness.

You must not circumvent any technical controls used to obtain the data.

3. Permitted use

You may use the Service for your own internal regulatory-compliance, research and operational purposes.

You must not:

- Resell, sublicense or redistribute the underlying reference data as a standalone or competing data feed without our permission and, where required, that of the relevant Source Provider
- Scrape or bulk-extract data to rebuild a Source Provider's dataset
- Circumvent security or rate limits
- Overload the Service or any upstream system
- Use the Service unlawfully

4. Accuracy, AI limitations and no warranty

Reference data is compiled from third parties and may be inaccurate, incomplete or out of date, and some sources do not retain historical records. The Service uses AI, whose outputs can contain errors or omissions and may not surface every relevant field or rule. The Service and all data and outputs are provided "as is" and "as available", without warranties of any kind, express or implied, including accuracy, fitness for a particular purpose or non-infringement. Use is at your own risk.

5. Limitation of liability

To the fullest extent permitted by law, we exclude all liability for any loss or damage, whether in contract, tort (including negligence), breach of statutory duty, or otherwise, even if foreseeable, arising under or in connection with:

- Use of, or inability to use, the Service; or use of or reliance on any content or output made available through the Service.

Nothing in this Policy excludes liability that cannot be excluded by law, including liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence or for fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation.

You will indemnify Gentek against third-party claims, liabilities, losses, damages and reasonable legal costs arising directly from:

- A. Your unlawful use of the Service;
- B. Material you submit to the Service that infringes another person's rights or that you were not entitled to provide;
- C. Your unauthorised redistribution of source data or outputs; or
- D. Your material breach of this Policy or an applicable Source Provider's terms.

This indemnity does not apply to the extent that the claim or loss was caused by Gentek's breach of contract, negligence, unlawful conduct or failure to comply with applicable law.

6. Data handling

The Service may be used with third-party AI systems, including large language models such as Anthropic's Claude or OpenAI's models, Microsoft Copilot, or other systems that connect to the Service using the Model Context Protocol (MCP). How your information is handled depends on the configuration:

Where Gentek selects and provides the AI system, Gentek processes your prompts and the resulting responses through that system, and that provider's terms and data-handling and privacy policies apply in addition to this Policy.

Where you select and control the AI system (for example, where your own Claude, ChatGPT or Copilot client connects to the Service via MCP), that client sends only the specific data requests needed to the Service, and the Service returns the requested information. Gentek receives only those requests and responses, not your full prompt or the AI system's final response, and keeps a limited record of them to operate the Service, diagnose errors and maintain security. The handling of your prompts and outputs by your chosen AI system is governed by that provider's own terms and policies, which may change and which Gentek does not control, and you are responsible for ensuring that the chosen provider is acceptable for your data.

Gentek does not itself use your prompts or responses to train any model. The Service is not intended for the input of special-category personal data, criminal-offence data or other highly sensitive personal information. You are responsible for ensuring you have a lawful basis for any personal data you input and for complying with applicable data-protection laws (including the UK GDPR) in respect of that data. You must not input personal, confidential or otherwise sensitive data that you are not entitled to share with the Service or the relevant AI provider.

7. Changes, suspension and acceptance

We may update this Policy from time to time. We will provide reasonable notice of any material changes. Your continued use of the Service after the effective date of a notified change constitutes acceptance of the updated Policy. Where required by law or where a change materially affects your rights, we may require you to confirm your acceptance before continuing to use the Service. We may suspend or terminate your access to the Service at any time, with or without notice, if you breach this Policy or if we reasonably suspect misuse.

If any provision of this Policy is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions continue in full force and effect. This Policy, together with the Terms and Conditions, Privacy Policy, Cookie Notice and Data Processing Agreement referred to above, is the entire agreement between you and Gentek regarding the Service and supersedes any prior understanding on its subject matter. In the event of any conflict between this Policy and the Terms and Conditions regarding liability, indemnity or termination, the Terms and Conditions prevail. No failure or delay by Gentek in exercising any right under this Policy operates as a waiver of that right. You may not assign or transfer your rights or obligations under this Policy; Gentek may assign or transfer its rights and obligations to a successor or affiliate.

This Policy and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with it (including non-contractual disputes or claims) are governed by the laws of England and Wales, and you and Gentek submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
