How to make your zine:

1. **Print** — Print double-sided on one sheet of paper. If you don't need the instructions, you can print just page 1, but make sure to print single-sided!
2. **Color** — Make it yours! Grab some colored pencils, markers, or whatever you have on hand.
3. **Fold lengthwise** — Fold the paper in half lengthwise (hot dog style), then unfold.
4. **Fold widthwise** — Fold in half the other way (hamburger style), then fold in the same direction once more.
5. **Unfold** — Unfold back to flat.
6. **Cut** — Cut a slit from the center fold toward the middle of the page — just to the center, not all the way through.
7. **Assemble** — Refold lengthwise, then stand the paper up and push the edges in toward the center. A diamond shape will open up — press it flat into a little booklet.
8. **Read & share** — Read it, then pass it to a friend!
