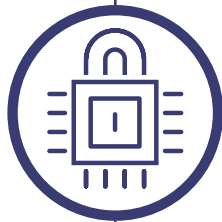

1. Acceptance of Terms

By accessing and using the Brazil Tech Regulation portal, including its restricted area, you confirm that you have read, understood, and agree to these Terms of Use and the Privacy Policy.

Access to the restricted area is conditioned upon your express acceptance of these Terms.

2. Access to the Restricted Area

2.1. Eligibility and Approval

Access to the restricted area is intended solely for clients and partners of Licks Attorneys and is granted upon request and prior approval, at the portal managers' sole discretion.

The portal managers reserve the right to:

- approve or deny access requests at their sole discretion;
- revoke, suspend, or restrict access at any time, with or without prior notice.

2.2. Personal and Non-Transferable Use

Access to the restricted area is personal, individual, and non-transferable. You may not:

- share your access credentials with any third party;
- allow unauthorized persons to use your access;
- use the portal for any unlawful or unauthorized purpose.





3. Authentication and Security

Access to the restricted area is provided through two-factor authentication, via a one-time passcode (OTP) sent to the registered and approved e-mail address.

3.1. User Responsibility

By using the portal, you acknowledge and agree that:

- access is linked to the security of your e-mail account;
- you are responsible for maintaining control and confidentiality of your e-mail and the access codes you receive;
- you must not share the access code with third parties under any circumstances;
- you are responsible for all activities conducted through your registered e-mail.

3.2. Limitation of Liability

The portal is not liable for unauthorized access resulting from:

- compromise of your e-mail account;
- failure to protect your personal devices or credentials.

4. Use of Content and Documents

The portal may make available content and materials classified as:

- publicly accessible content, available to any user;
- restricted content, available only to pre-authorized users.

4.1. Public Content

Publicly accessible content may be freely accessed and shared, subject to the intellectual property provisions set out under these Terms

4.2. Restricted Content

Content made available in the restricted area is for the personal and/or internal use of authorized users only. You may not:

- reproduce, distribute, share, or disclose such content to unauthorized third parties;
- use the content for unauthorized commercial purposes;
- make the materials available on external platforms or public networks.

4.3. Third-Party Content

Certain materials may be owned by third parties and will be accompanied by specific notices regarding their source and responsibility. To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, the portal disclaims any responsibility for the content or updating of those materials.



5. Intellectual Property
