CD/ANPD'S DECISION ORDER #122/2026

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BRAZILIAN DATA PROTECTION AGENCY (ANPD), in the exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Article 34 of Statute #15,211 of September 17, 2025, and Article 2 of Decree #12,622 of September 17, 2025, which designates the ANPD as the autonomous administrative authority for the protection of children and adolescents in digital environments, with the jurisdiction to supervise compliance with the law and issue complementary rules.

WHEREAS Article 31 of Statute #15,211 of 2025 created the obligation to prepare semi-annual transparency reports in Portuguese, to be published on the websites of internet application providers that target children and adolescents, or are likely to be accessed by them, and that have more than 1,000,000 (one million) registered users within this age group with an internet connection in the national territory, further observing the provisions of Article 45 of Decree #12,880 of 2026;

WHEREAS it is timely to provide clarifications regarding the calculation of the deadline for preparing and publishing the first semi-annual report, without prejudice to any subsequent regulations;

WHEREAS Article 41-A of Statute #15,211 of 2025, as worded by Statute #15,352 of 2026, establishes March 17, 2026, as the effective date for the obligations provided for in the Statute; and

WHEREAS the provisions of Article 39 of Statute #15,211 of 2025 modulate the application of the obligation provided for in Article 31 and establish cases of exemption from its compliance; decide:

- I. To communicate that the deadline relating to the obligation to publish the semi-annual transparency reports provided for in Article 31 of Statute #15,211 of 2025 shall be calculated from the entry into force of the Statute, on March 17, 2026, pursuant to its Article 41-A.
- II. To clarify that the first report shall cover the period between January 1, 2026, and June 30, 2026. Considering that the legal obligation only entered into force as of March 17, 2026, providers that do not have information regarding the months of January and February 2026 may limit the initial report to the period between March 17 and June 30, 2026, without prejudice to subsequent reports coinciding with regular calendar semesters.
- III. To inform that the first semi-annual report, regardless of the period covered pursuant to Item I, shall be published by September 17, 2026.
- IV. To establish, pending specific regulation, that as of the second report, the periods covered shall coincide with the regular calendar semesters (January 1 to June 30, and July 1 to December 31), and each report must be published on the provider's website by August 1 for the period referencing the first semester, and by February 1 for the period referencing the second semester.
- V. To clarify that, pending specific regulation, the report shall contain, in a single document, at least the information required by Items I through VII of Article 31 of Statute #15,211, of 2025, and by Items I and II of Article 45 of Decree #12,880 of 2026, namely:
 - A. the channels available for receiving reports and the investigation systems and procedures;
 - B. the number of reports received;
 - C. the number of content or account moderations, by type;
 - D. the measures adopted to identify children's accounts on social media,

- pursuant to Paragraph 3 of Article 24, and unlawful acts, pursuant to Article 27 of the Statute;
- E. the technical enhancements for the protection of personal data and the privacy of children and adolescents;
 - F. the technical enhancements to verify parental consent, pursuant to Paragraph 1 of Article 14 of Statute #13,709 of 2018 (General Data Protection Act); and
 - G. the detailing of the methods used and the presentation of the results of impact assessments, identification, and management of risks to the safety and health of children and adolescents;
- VI. Additionally, Article 45 of Decree #12,880/2026 establishes that, with respect to the number of reports received (Item II of Article 31), the report shall include:
- A. the number of notifications received, by category; and
 - B. proportional data on the follow-up given to the notifications received;
- VII. To register that the following are exempt from publishing semi-annual reports, pursuant to Article 31, combined with Article 39 of Statute #15,211, of 2025:
- A. providers that do not reach 1,000,000 (one million) registered users within the children and adolescent age group with an internet connection in the national territory; and
 - B. service providers with editorial control and providers of copyrighted content previously licensed from a responsible economic agent that is not a final user, provided that the conditions set forth in Items I through IV of Paragraph 1 of Article 39 are met;
- VIII. To recommend that the obligated parties forward a copy of the semi-annual report, upon its publication, to the email address monitoramento@anpd.gov.br, without prejudice to the publication on the provider's website required by Article 31.
- IX. To order the publication of this Decision Order in the Federal Register and on the website of the Brazilian Data Protection Agency, for the notice of regulated parties and society; and
- X. To order the referral of the case dockets to the Enforcement Commissioner and the Regulation Commissioner, for their awareness and the adoption of applicable measures within the scope of their jurisdictions.

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1st report	January 1 to June 30, 2026. Exceptionally, for providers that do not have information regarding the months of January and February 2026, the period covered is from March 17 to June 30, 2026.	By September 17, 2026.
2nd report onwards	First semester: January 1 to June 30 Second semester: July 1 to December 31	By August 1, for the period referencing the first semester, and by February 1, for the period referencing the second semester.
