Installation instructions

Step 1

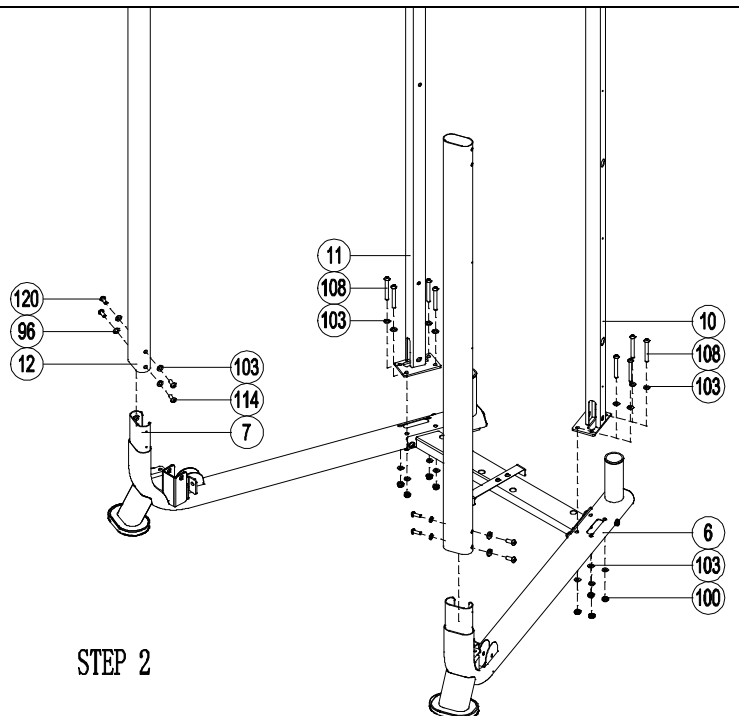
- Attach the base frame (2), the right base frame (6) and the left base frame (7) together, fix using hex large flat head full tooth bolt (114), hex large flat head half tooth bolt (106), flat washer (103) and hex lock nut (100).
- Attach the fixed plate for cover (36) to the base frame (2), fix using hex large flat head half tooth bolt (117), flat washer (102) and hex lock nut (101).

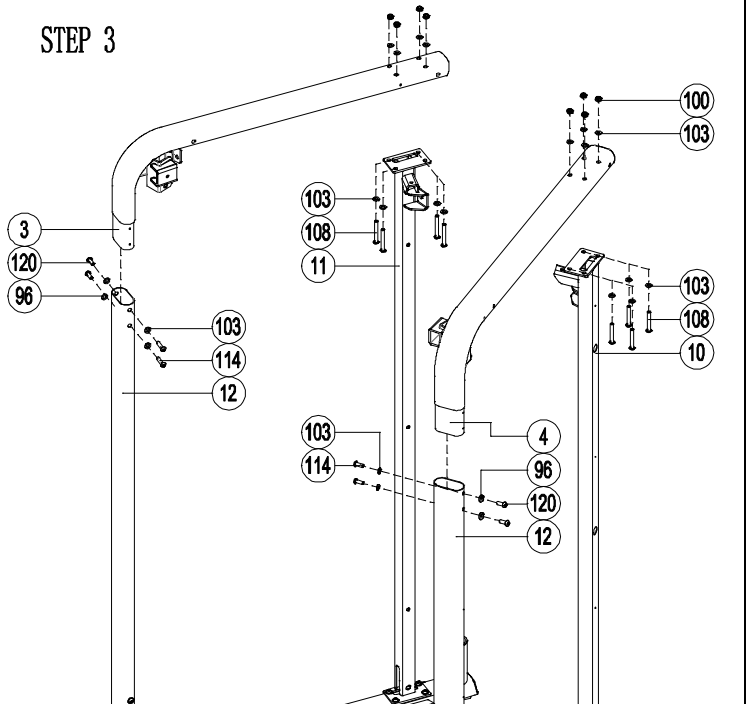
- Attach one front vertical frame (12) to the left base frame (7), fix using hex large flat head full tooth bolt (114), flat washer (103), hex countersunk head full tooth bolt (120) and fisheye washer (96) as picture shown.
- Attach the left rear vertical frame (11) to the left base frame (7), fix using hex large flat head half tooth bolt (108), flat washer (103) and hex lock nut (100).
- Follow above steps to attach the other front vertical frame (12) and the right rear vertical frame (10) to the right base frame (6).

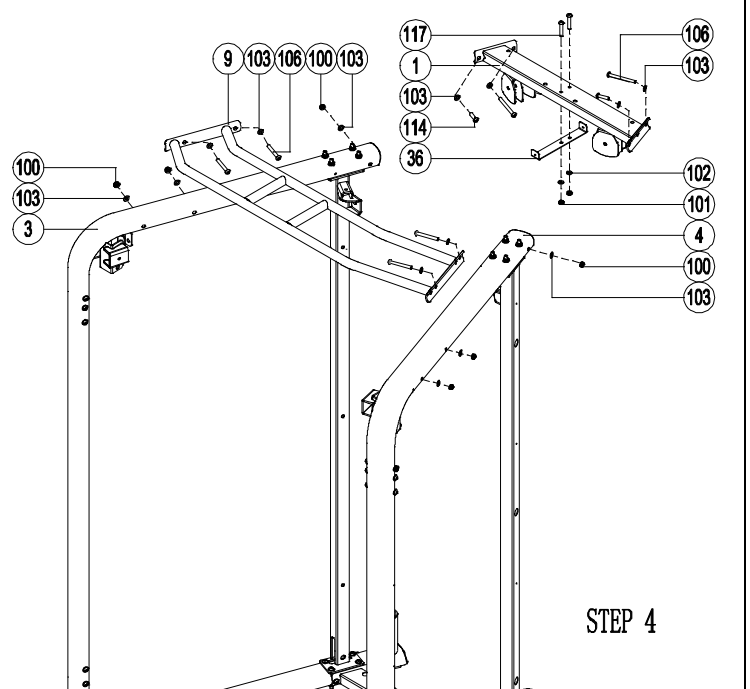
Step 3

- Attach one end of the left upper elbow frame (3) to the front vertical frame (12), fix using hex large flat head full tooth bolt (114), flat washer (103), hex countersunk head full tooth bolt (120) and fisheye washer (96) as picture shown.
- Attach the other end of the left upper elbow frame (3) to the left rear vertical frame (11), fix using hex large flat head half tooth bolt (108), flat washer (103) and hex lock nut (100).
- Follow above steps to attach the right upper elbow frame (4) onto the other front vertical frame (12) and the right rear vertical frame (10).



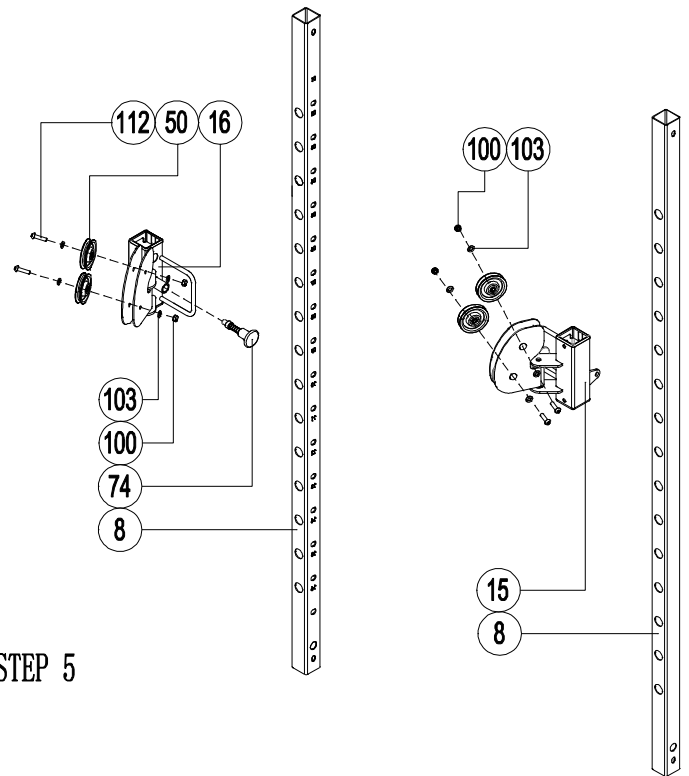
Step 4

- As picture shown, attach the upper frame (1) to the left upper elbow frame (3) and the right upper elbow frame (4), fix using hex large flat head full tooth bolt (114), hex large flat head half tooth bolt (106), flat washer (103), and hex lock nut (100).
- As picture shown, attach the pull-up bar (9) to the left upper elbow frame (3) and the right upper elbow frame (4), fix using hex large flat head half tooth bolt (106), flat washer (103), and hex lock nut (100).



Step 5

- Attach the pulleys (50) into the left cable slider (16), fix using hex large flat head half tooth bolt (112), flat washer (103) and hex lock nut (100).
- Pull the pull pin (74) from the left cable slider (16) manually, then insert one adjustable upright post (8), and release the pull pin (74).
- Follow above steps to attach the right cable slider (15) to the other adjustable upright post (8).

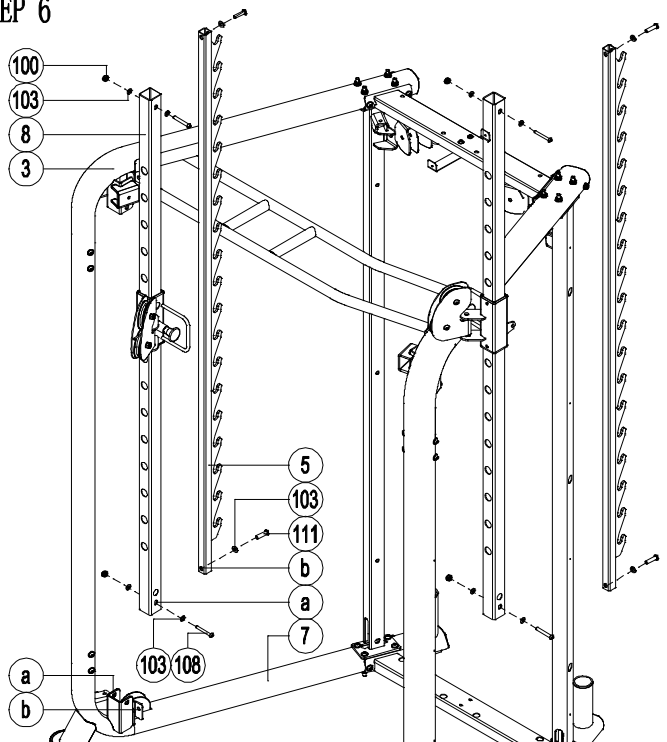


STEP 5

- As picture shown, attach one adjustable upright post (8) to the left base frame (7) by aligning hole (a), fix using hex large flat head half tooth bolt (108), flat washer (103) and hex lock nut (100) on both ends of the adjustable upright post.
- Attach the Smith adjustable rail (5) to the left base frame (7) by aligning hole (b), fix using hex large flat head half tooth bolt (111) and flat washer (103) on both ends of the Smith adjustable rail.
- Follow above steps to attach the other adjustable upright post (8) and the other Smith adjustable rail (5) to the right base frame (6).

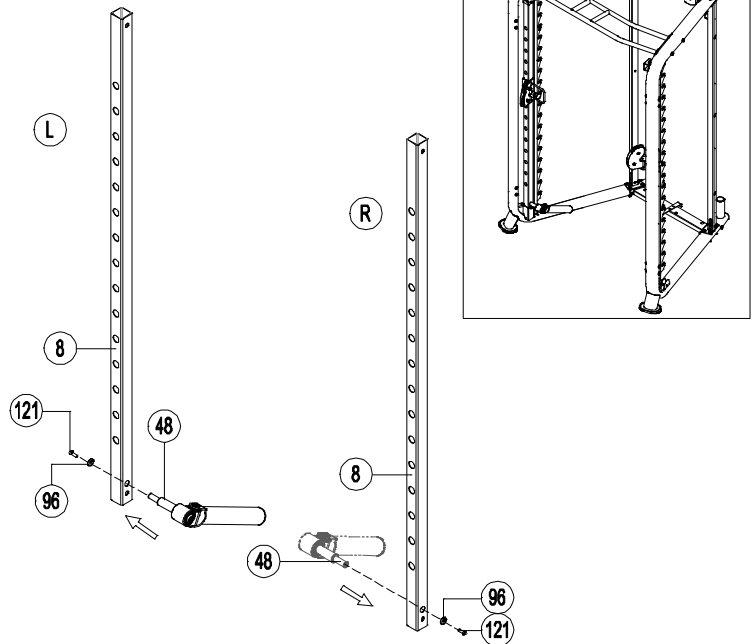

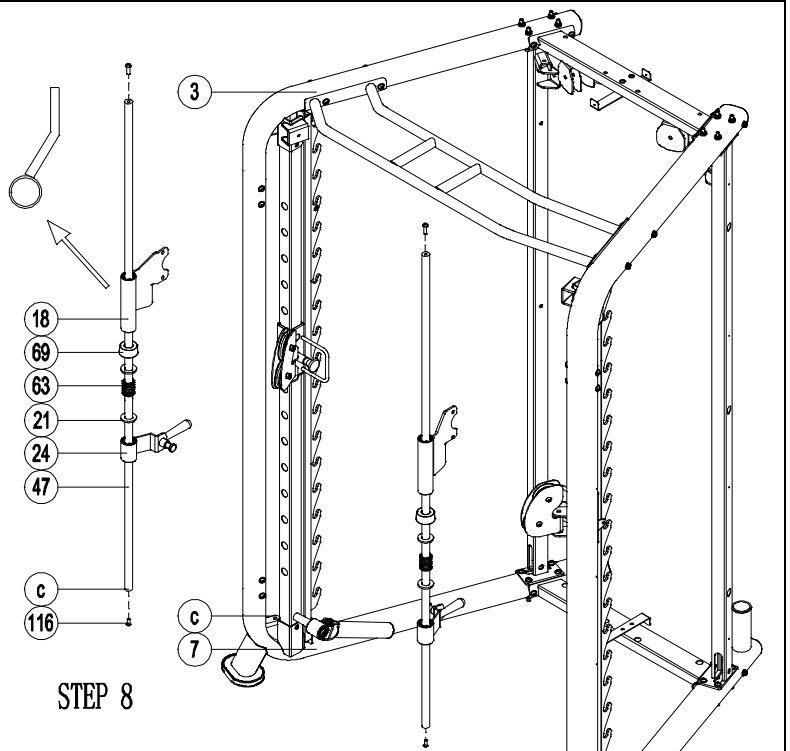
- Following the preferred hole position, insert the long bar (48) into the adjustable upright post (8), fix using hex countersunk head full tooth bolt (121) and fisheye washer (96). The long bar can be arranged into both left and right adjustable upright posts (8).

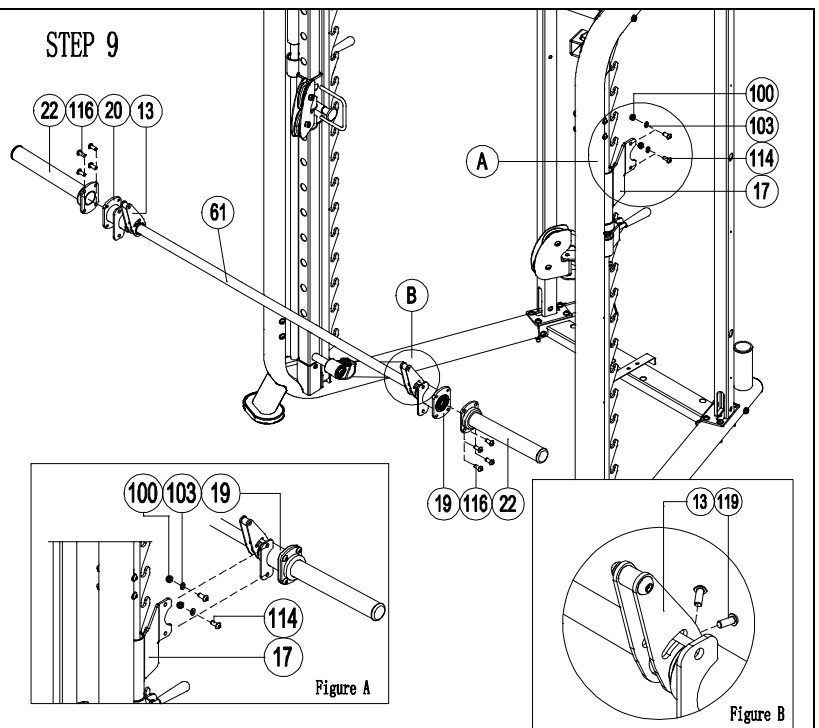
Step 8

- As picture shown, put the left Smith bar holder (18), the rubber bumper (69), the rubber bumper (21), the Smith spring (63) and the left safety stopper (24) along the Smith weight bar guide rod (47).
- Fix the Smith weight bar guide rod (47) to position (C) by aligning the hole, attach the lower end to the left base frame (7) and the upper end to the left upper elbow frame (3) by using hex large flat head full tooth bolt (116).
- Follow above steps to attach the other Smith weight bar guide rod (47) to the other side.



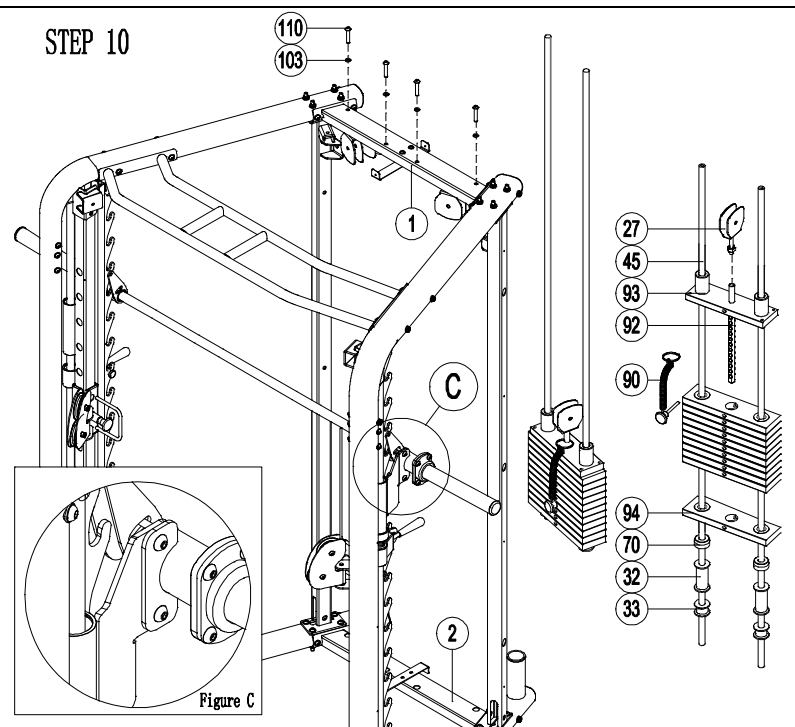
Step 9

- Attach the weight plate post (22) to both ends of the Smith weight bar (61), fix using hex large flat head full tooth bolt (116).
- As figure B shown, loosen hex large flat head full tooth bolt (119) from the two Smith hooks (13), adjust proper distance between the hooks and ensure secured hanging, then tighten the hex large flat head full tooth bolt (119).
- As figure A shown, attach the right Smith bar connecting sleeve (19) to the right weight bar holder (17), fix using hex large flat head full tooth bolt (114), flat washer (103) and hex lock nut (100).
- Follow above steps to attach the other weight plate post (22) to the other side.



Step 10

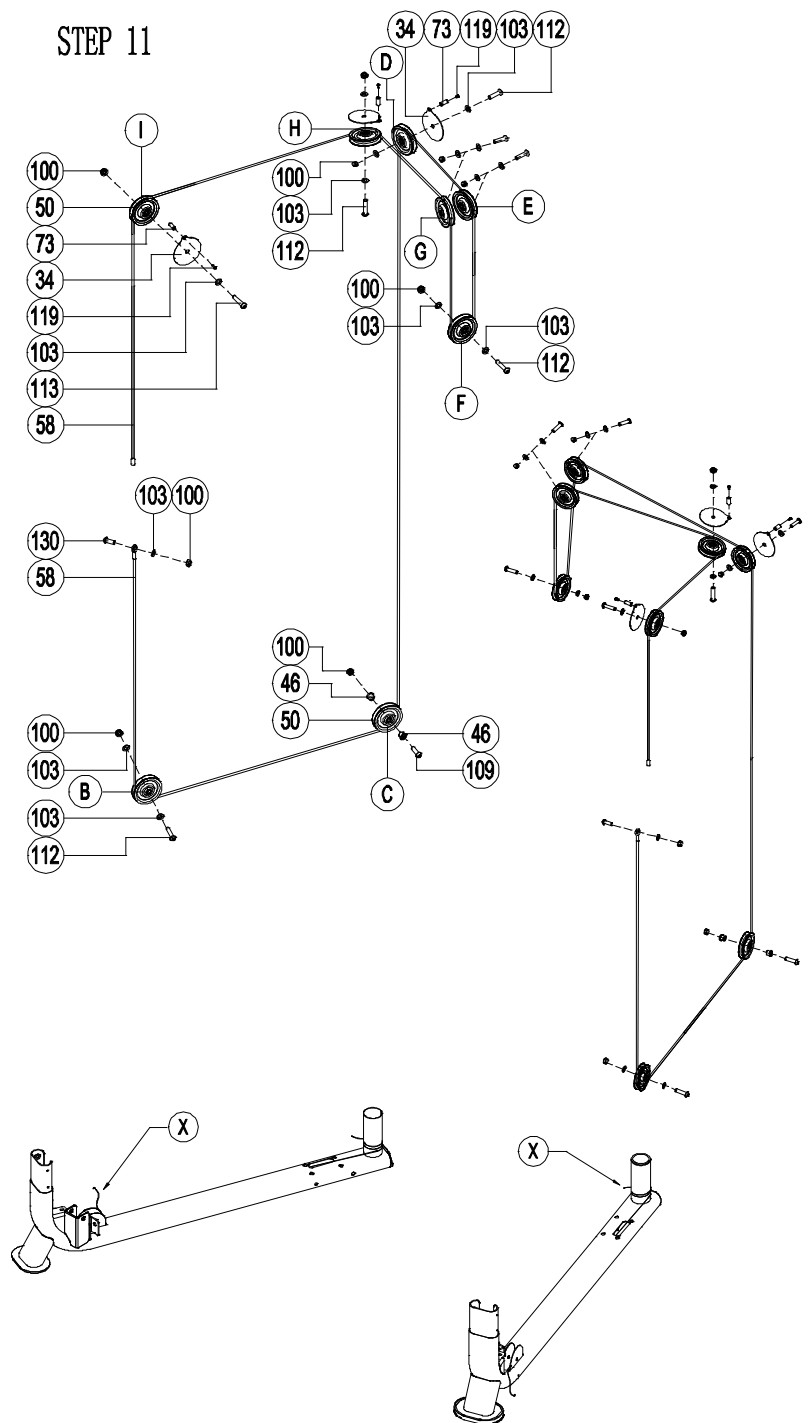
- Attach the two weight guide rods (45) on the same side to the base frame (2), put the short weight elevated bracket (33), the long weight elevated bracket (32), the rubber bumper (70), 11 pcs weight plates (94) and the top weight plate (93) along each guide rod as picture shown.
- ***NOTE: if it's optional 180KGS weight stacks, remove the long weight elevated bracket (32), and put 17 pcs weight plates (94) along each guide rod.
- Attach one end of the stack select pin (90) to the top weight plate (93), while the other end to weight plate (94) as picture shown.
 - Attach the pulley assembly (27) to the top weight plate (93) as picture shown.



Step 11

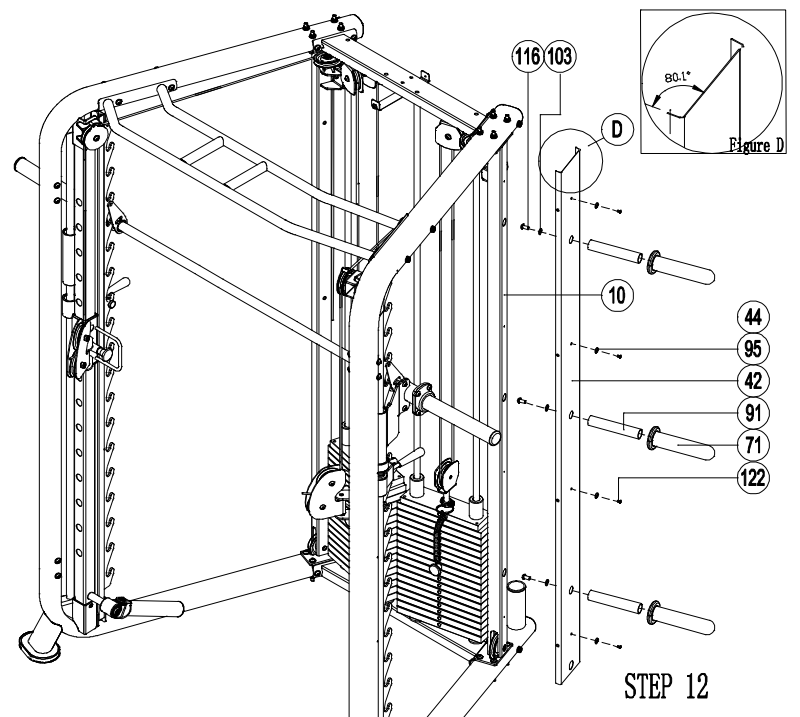
- Following the routing diagram as picture shown, feed the cable (58) from pulley B to pulley I (For easy assembly, an auxiliary lead (X) is placed in the left/right base frame in advance. During cable feeding, the lead can be wrapped around the end of the cable to pull it out from the base frame. After installation, the lead can be removed.)
- Start the pulley B assembly firstly, fix using hex large flat head half tooth bolt (112), flat washer (103) and hex lock nut (100). Follow same steps for the pulley E, F, G assembly.
- For the pulley C assembly, fix using hex large flat head half tooth bolt (109), plastic sleeve (46) and hex lock nut (100).
- For the pulley D, H assembly, fix the pulley plate (34) using hex large flat head full tooth bolt (119) and screw sleeve (73), then attach the pulley to the pulley plate (34) using hex large flat head half tooth bolt (112), flat washer (103) and hex lock nut (100).
- For the pulley I assembly, fix the pulley plate (34) using hex large flat head full tooth bolt (119) and screw sleeve (73), then attach the pulley to the pulley plate (34) using hex large flat head full tooth bolt (113), flat washer (103) and hex lock nut (100).
- When the cable arrives the pulley bracket (14) from step 5, tie a knot between the two pulleys, fix the cable end using hex large flat head full tooth bolt (130), flat washer (103) and hex lock nut (100).
- Follow above steps for the pulley assembly and cable feeding for the other side.

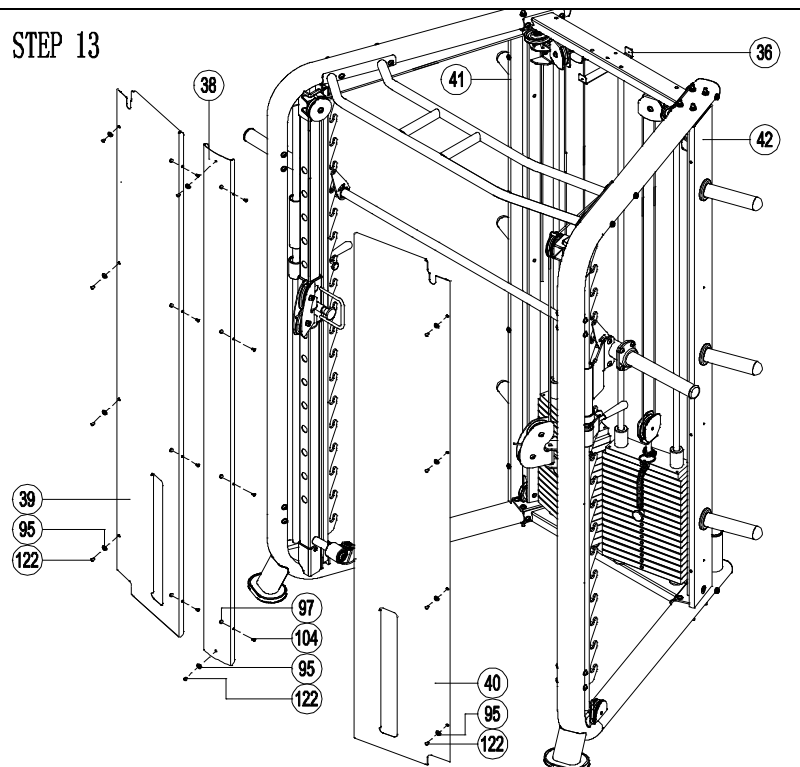
- As picture shown, attach the right side cover (42) to the right rear vertical frame (10), fix using cross recessed countersunk head full tooth bolt (122) and fisheye washer (95).
- Insert the weight bar (91) into the right rear vertical frame (10), fix using hex large flat head full tooth bolt (116) and flat washer (103).
- Put the weight bar adaptor (71) onto the weight bar (91), tighten the screws assorted with the weight bar adaptor.
- Follow above steps to attach the left side cover (41), the left rear vertical frame (11), the weight bar (91) and the weight bar adaptor (71) on the other side.

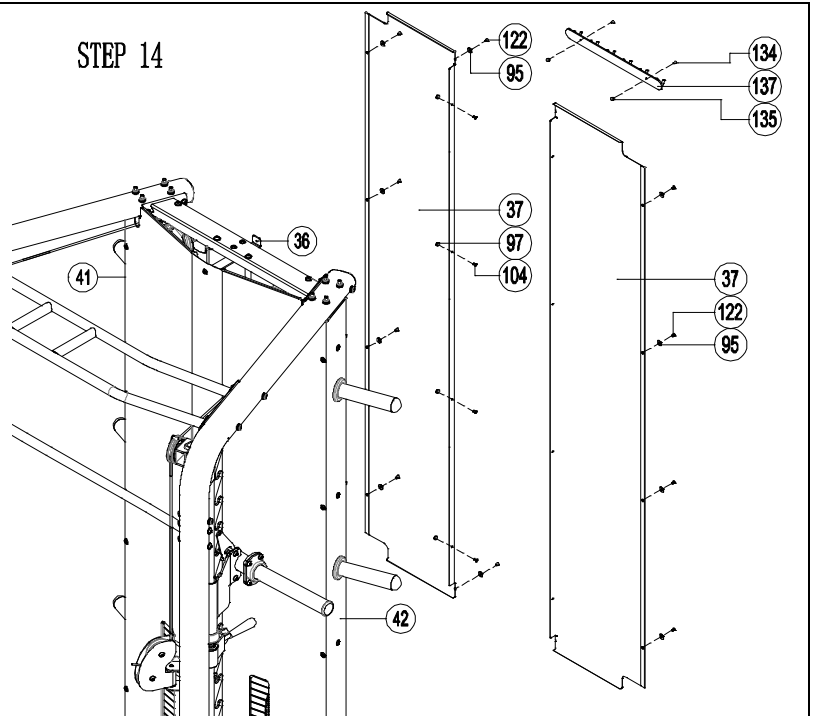
- Attach the left front cover (39) to the left side cover (41), fix using cross recessed countersunk head full tooth bolt (122) and fisheye washer (95).
- Attach the front R-cover (38) to the upper and lower fixed plate for covers (36), fix using cross recessed countersunk head full tooth bolt (122) and fisheye washer (95).
- Attach the right front cover (40) to the right side cover (42), fix using cross recessed countersunk head full tooth bolt (122) and fisheye washer (95).
- Fix the three covers (38) (39) (40) using cross recessed countersunk head full tooth bolt (104) and hex nut (97).

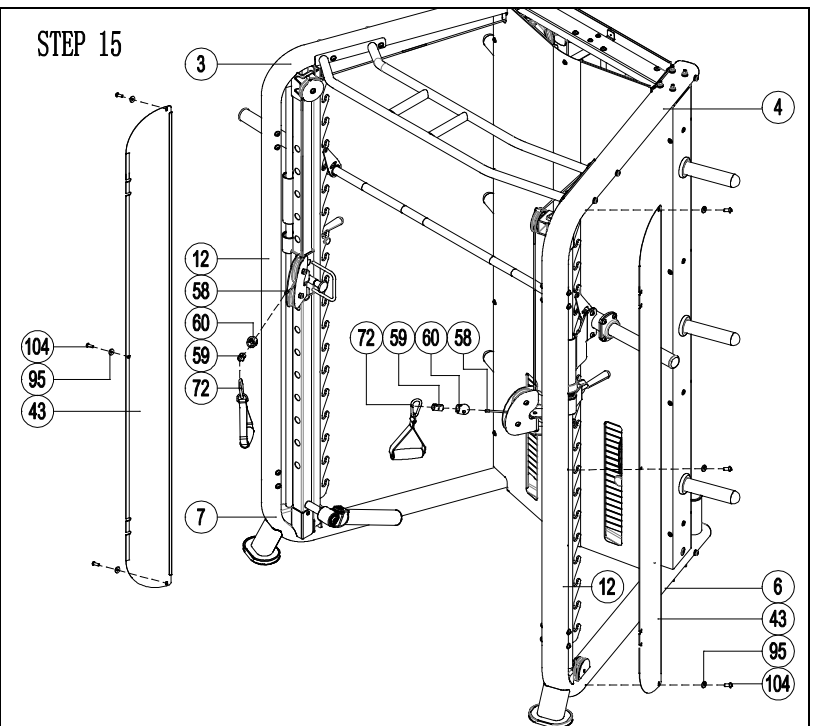

- Fix the two rear covers (37) using cross recessed countersunk head full tooth bolt (104) and hex nut (97). Then attach the accessory rack (137) onto the rear covers (37), fix using cross recessed large flat head full tooth bolt (134) and hex lock nut (135).
- Attach the assembled rear covers (37) to the left and the right side cover (41) (42) respectively, fix using cross recessed countersunk head full tooth bolt (122) and fisheye washer (95).



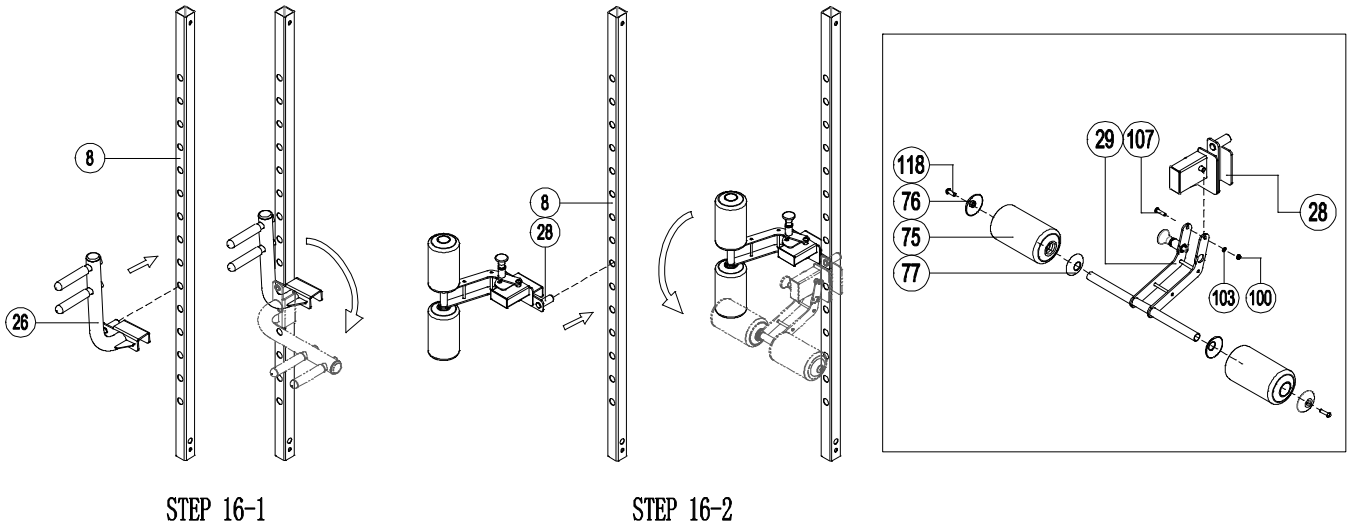

- Attach the two front side covers to the front vertical frames (12), the left/right upper elbow frame (3) (4) and the left/right base frame (7)(6) respectively, fix using cross recessed countersunk head full tooth bolt (104) and fisheye washer (95).
- As picture shown, feed the two cables (58) from bushing cover (60), bushing inner shaft (59) to the snap hook (72) respectively, where the snap hook is hooking the bushing inner shaft.

Accessories assembly:

- 16-1: As picture shown, insert the left dip bar (26) into the adjustable upright post (8), rotate 90 degrees to fix it. Follow above steps for the right dip bar (25) assembly.
- 16-2: As picture shown, put the foam inner cover (77), leg press foam roll (75) and foam outer cover (76) to the leg press (29), fix using hex large flat head full tooth bolt (118).
- Fix the safety bar (28) and the leg press (29) using hex large flat head half tooth bolt (107), flat washer (103) and hex lock nut (100). Insert the safety bar (28) into the adjustable upright post (8), rotate 90 degrees to fix it, as picture shown.

For a period of either 120 days or 24 months after the purchase date (the “Warranty Period”), a warranty will apply on moving parts, pulley's, cables, buttons, upholstery, hydraulic seats and cables for a period of 120 days, with the balance of the machine being a 24 month warranty. SKELCORE warrants that the equipment for materials and workmanship such that, when installed and used in accordance with the owner's manual, will operate for its intended purpose. The warranty applies to equipment installed in air conditioned and temperature controlled environments and will be null and void if used outdoors or in an environment with no air conditioning. SKELCORE will, at its expense and as its sole obligation and your exclusive remedy for any breach of this warranty, repair or replace the equipment or any parts, in its discretion, provided that such malfunction or defect is reported to SKELCORE by you in writing during the Warranty Period and that you provide all information that may be necessary or requested to assist SKELCORE in resolving the malfunction. If SKELCORE determines that it is unable to repair the malfunction or replace the equipment, SKELCORE or its authorized reseller may refund you the fees you actually paid for the defective equipment, in which case you agree to immediately cease using and to destroy, throw out, or otherwise take steps to ensure no one can use the equipment ever again.

If there are any problems or malfunctions with the SKELCORE equipment you purchased, please contact your sales manager promptly. They will help you identify the cause of the problem and assist you in resolving it. If the issue involves parts that cannot be quickly addressed, the company's professional after-sales service personnel will provide specialized support.

COST OF REPAIRS

UNDER WARRANTY

Any items still under warranty will be repaired free of charge, if the repair complies with the terms and conditions of the warranty (refer to the “warranties” section in this manual). Any items that need to be repaired that are not covered under the warranty will be at your expense. A quote for the repair or replacement of these items will be provided to you for approval prior to any repairs being conducted.

OUT OF WARRANTY

Any items that need to be repaired once the warranty has expired will be at your expense, including call-out fees. A quote for the repair or replacement of these items will be provided to you for approval prior to any repairs being conducted.
