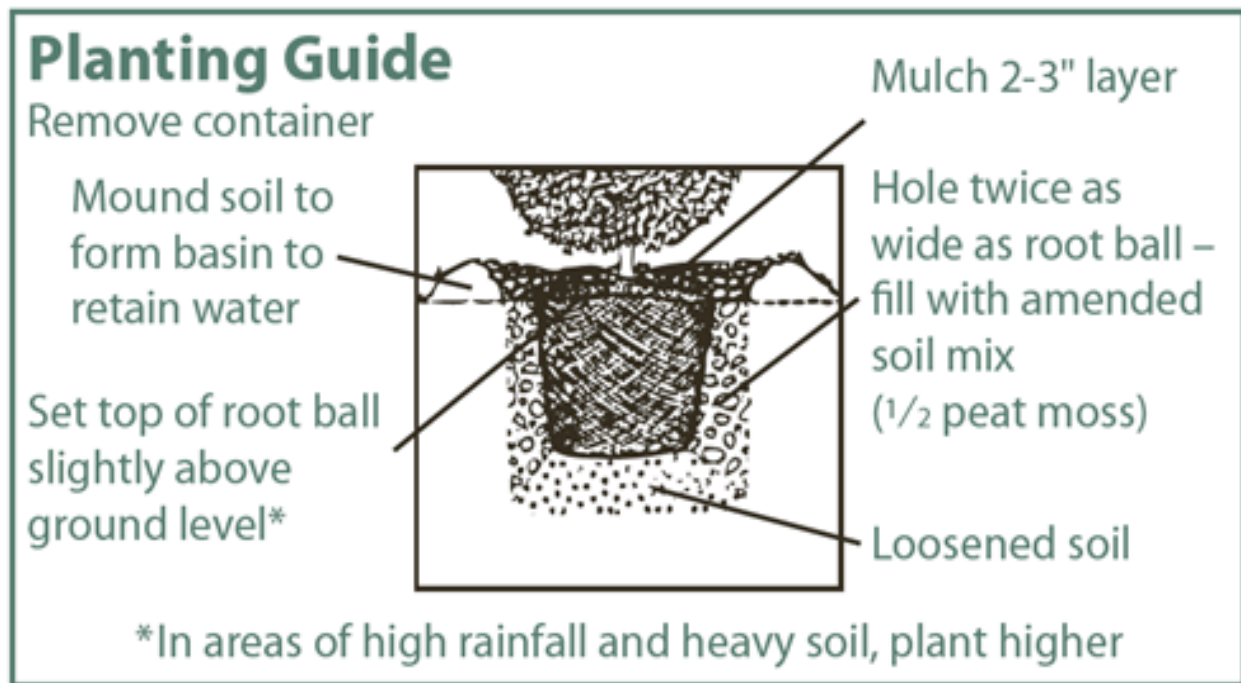


Premier Planting Instructions.

1. Dig a hole twice as wide as the container and a few inches deeper. Loosen the soil at the bottom.
2. Fill the bottom of the hole with amended soil and tamp it down.
3. Remove the plant from its container and gently loosen the soil around the roots.
4. Place the plant in the hole, ensuring that the top of the root ball is 1-2" above ground level.
5. Fill the hole with amended soil and lightly tamp to remove air pockets.
6. Mound the soil to form a basin for water retention around the plant.
7. Add a 2-3" layer of mulch around the plant. Don't put mulch on tree trunk
8. Water the plant well after it's planted. Thereafter, water thoroughly at signs of wilting - especially until the roots grow into the surrounding soil.



Watering Needs

- Water your new plant every day for 1 week, every other day for the second and third weeks, and then as required. It's best to water early in the mornings. After that, water as required depending on weather conditions.
- For clay soil, water your new plant every other day for a week and then every third day for the second and third week. After that, water as required depending on weather conditions.
- Try to water at the base of the plant, near the soil since watering the plant's leaves can increase the risk of disease.
- Don't forget about your plants when you go on vacation - have someone stop by and water them.
- If your plant's leaves become droopy or wilted, it may need a good watering.
