RE: Supplemental submission to 22 September 2025 notarized complaint - request for intake, preservation, record testing, appropriate referral, and acknowledgment

Dear State Department Inspector General / Hotline Intake:

I submit the accompanying supplemental complaint to update, correct, and strengthen - not replace - my notarized complaint executed on 22 September 2025. The original complaint and its exhibit volume should remain part of the historical record. Where the supplemental complaint expressly corrects or qualifies earlier wording, I ask that the supplemental filing state my present, source-controlled position.

The filing reports serious cross-border threats, violent incidents, and official or official-appearing contacts, and asks OIG to test whether any Department, Diplomatic Security, passport, consular, contractor, or liaison records corroborate, contradict, or exclude a Department nexus. I do not ask OIG to presume that a person who claimed an official affiliation actually held one, or that any alleged criminal act has already been proven. I ask OIG to let objective records and independent witnesses control.

I respectfully request that OIG:

- Associate the supplemental complaint with the 22 September 2025 notarized complaint as one continuing oversight record, while preserving the original filing unchanged.
- Preserve and review the Department, DSS, passport, ACS/OCS, RSO, consular, contractor, referral, and liaison records identified in the supplemental complaint, to the extent permitted by OIG authority and applicable law.
- Verify claimed identities and affiliations; reconstruct how my reports and personal information were received, routed, retained, shared, referred, or closed; and refer or coordinate any substantiated matter outside State OIG jurisdiction with the competent authority as appropriate.
- Acknowledge receipt and provide any complaint, reference, or tracking number assigned to this submission.
- Protect my precise current location and non-public witness/source identifiers to the extent permitted by law and operationally feasible.

Separate FOIA and Privacy Act requests are being submitted independently; this cover letter and hotline complaint do not substitute for those statutory request processes.

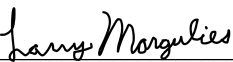
