THE HARROW LEARNING EXPERIENCE

Harrow is where younger students take their first step into independent learning. Programmes run for one week, taught in small classes by expert tutors, with the balance tipped towards curiosity and confidence rather than exam preparation. Students try a subject properly, often for the first time, and find out what they enjoy.

The campus sits on the edge of London, with historic boarding houses, extensive sports facilities, and green space to run around in. Structured supervision runs throughout the day and evening, so students gain independence in a setting built to look after them.



FEATURED SUBJECT AREAS

Creative Writing

Students build characters, shape plots, and try out a voice of their own. Workshop sessions give them an audience for their work and the confidence to share it, which for many is the harder half of writing.

Science and Discovery

Hands-on experiments across biology, chemistry, and physics, structured around questions rather than syllabus. Students learn to test an idea, record what happens, and explain what it means.

Debating and Public Speaking

Students learn to organise an argument, listen properly to the other side, and speak in front of a room. The skills transfer straight back to the classroom at home.

A WEEK AT HARROW

For many students Harrow is a first time away from home, and the week is built around that. Days follow a clear rhythm of lessons, activities, and downtime, with staff present throughout. Parents receive updates through the week.

In the classroom

Small classes led by expert tutors, pitched to the age group. Sessions are discussion-led and project-based, so students speak up, ask questions, and work through problems together.

Boarding life

Students stay in Harrow's boarding houses with residential staff on hand day and night. Meals are taken together in the dining hall, and house-based groups give every student a small, familiar circle from the first evening.

Beyond the classroom

Afternoons and evenings bring sport on the school grounds, creative workshops, and organised social events. Weekend excursions take students into London and beyond, with staff supervision throughout.

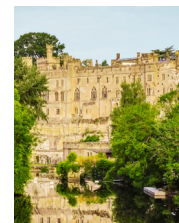

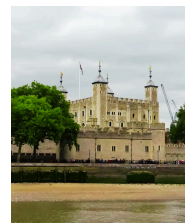
Harry Potter Studios Tour
