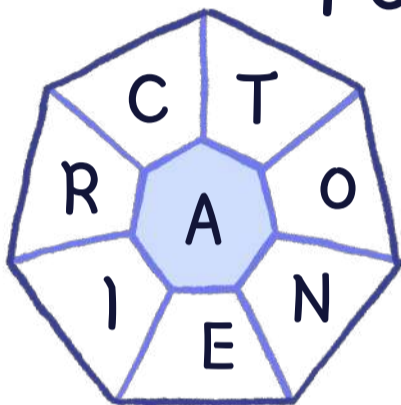

Write a sentence using the word 'simultaneously'.

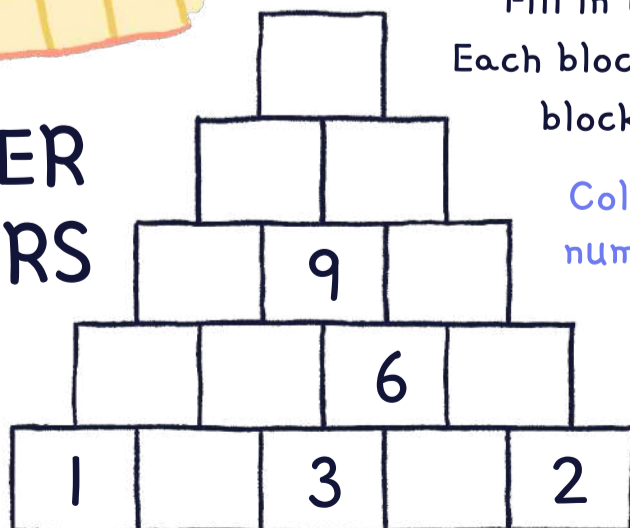
Synonym: together, at the same time

Example: The children clapped *simultaneously* when the show ended.

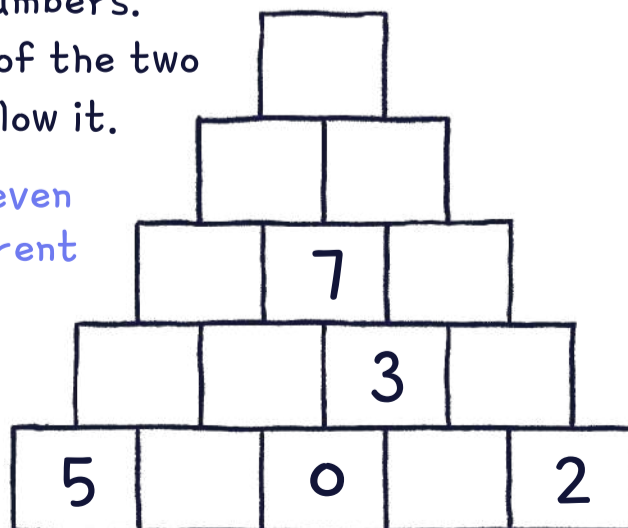
