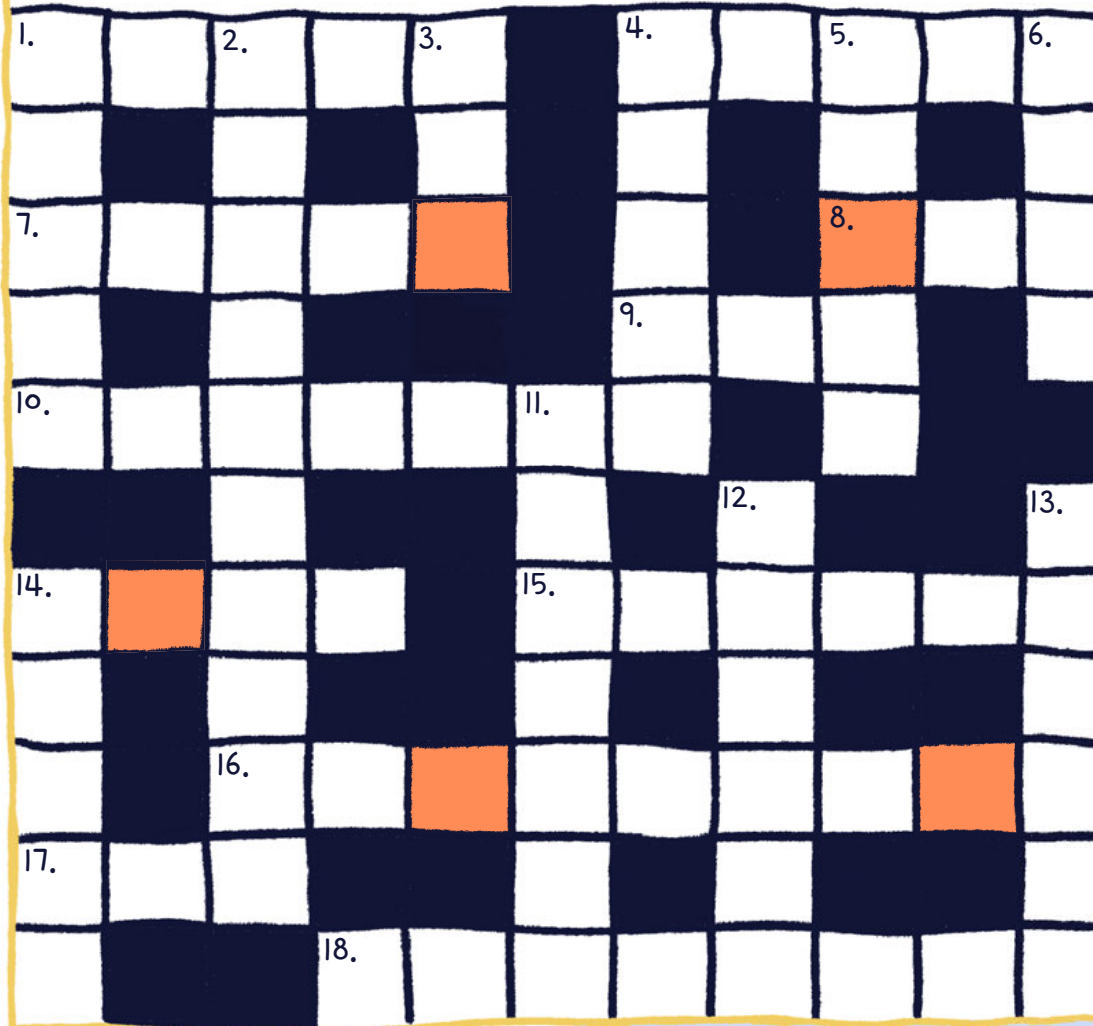


CROSSWORD
