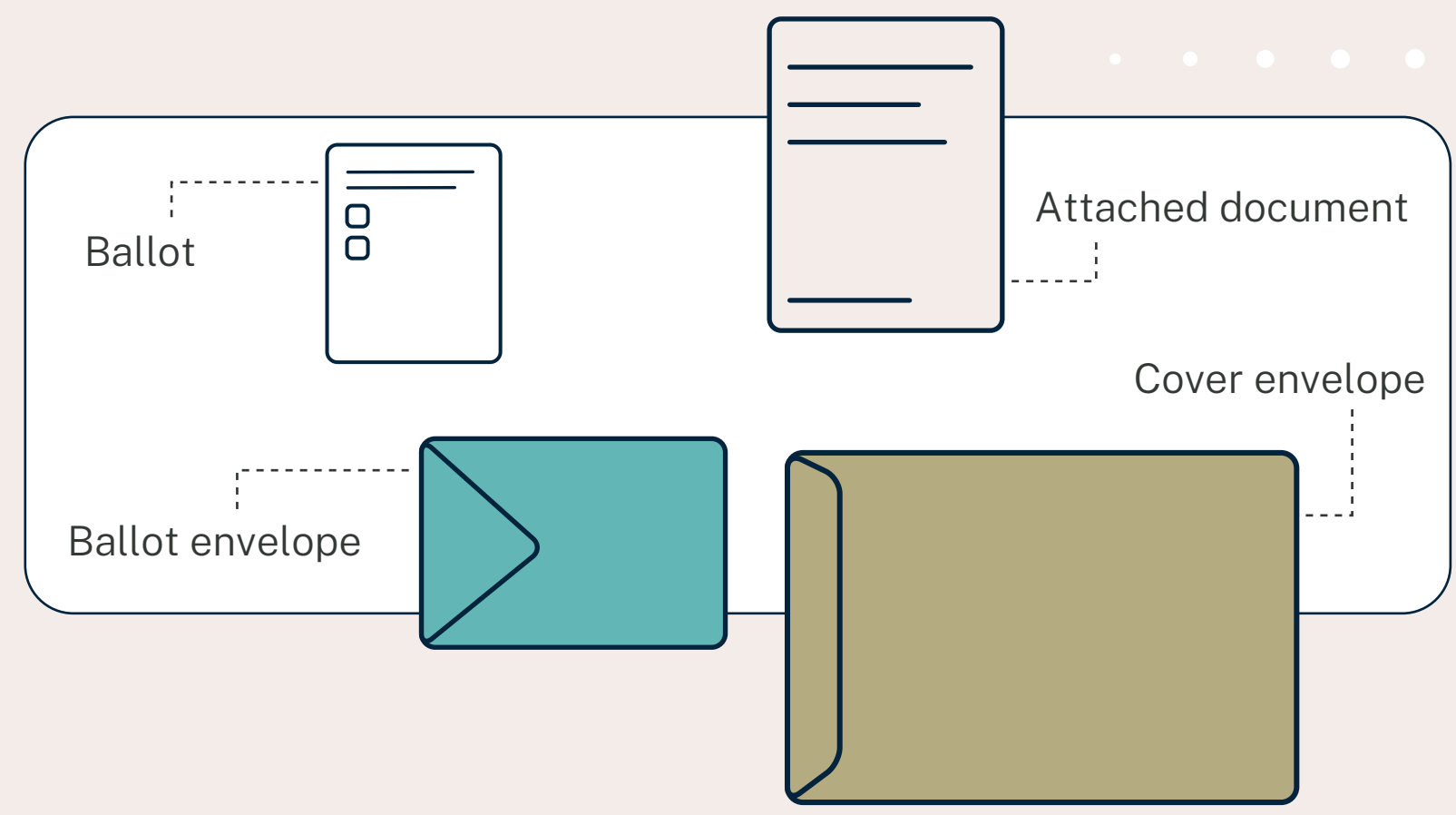


Early voting

Identify yourself

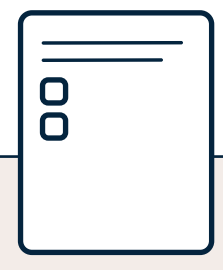
At the polling station, present your ID to receive the voting documents. IDs are official documents such as passports, ID cards, and driver's licenses.



Voting process

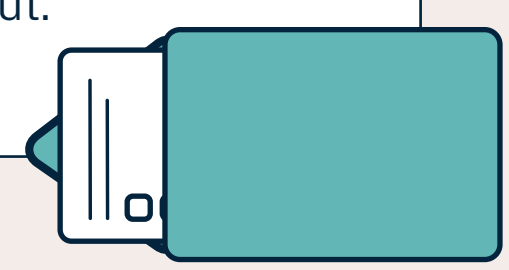
1

Mark X in the square in front of the answer option you wish to vote for.



2

Place the ballot into the ballot envelope (the smaller envelope) and glue it shut.



3

Fill out the attached document and sign it. The election official must also sign it.



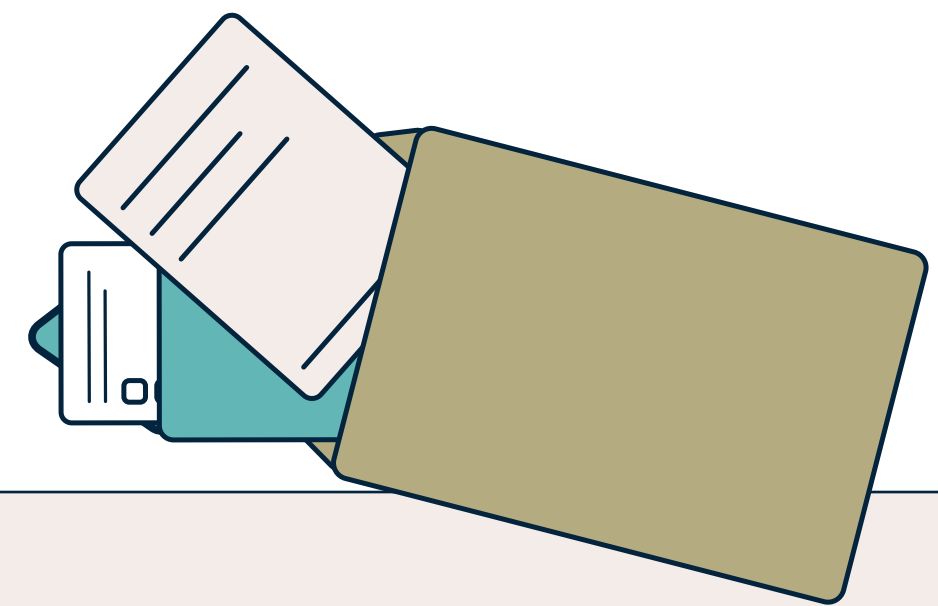
4

Place the attached document and ballot envelope in the cover envelope and glue it shut.

Write the name and address of the municipality where you are registered to vote.

Write your own name and address on the back of the cover envelope.

If you live abroad, you should write the last address you had in Iceland.

Turning in your ballot

If you are voting at the office of the District Commissioner in your district, you can place the ballot into a ballot box at the voting office.

B

If you are voting at the office of a District Commissioner outside your district, or abroad, you are responsible for ensuring that your ballot reaches the municipality where you are domiciled before the end of election day.

Voters may ask the election official to send their ballot through ordinary postal services, but this does not guarantee that it will arrive on time.



Please note

Do not write on your ballot or use other symbols.

No one may see how you cast your vote.

You can ask for a new ballot if you make a mistake.
