### AROMA

blackberry, tar, lilac

### FLAVOR

black currant, purple basil, fun dip

### FOOD PAIRINGS

kimchi hot dog, tacos al pastor, paella

### VINIFICATION

This old vine, dry-farmed, head-trained **Carignan** (87%) & **Valdiguie** (13%) was hand-harvested in mid to late Sept. Multiple fermentation methods were employed (whole cluster + true carbonic). All lots aged separately in neutral oak barrels & steel for 10-months. Bottled unfiltered/unfiltered.

### SITE

Composed from three historic Mendocino County ranches—two on the valley floor, one at high elevation—all with heritage dry-farmed, head-trained Carignan + Valdiguie vines. Soils range from red clay (valley) to hard scabble rocky (mountain). These rapidly vanishing California grapes harken back to the Golden State's earliest winemaking efforts.
