SITE

This historic vineyard atop Moon Mountain boasts some of the state's oldest Cabernet Sauvignon. The vineyard takes its name from the mineral-rich, red clay soils that define the wines. We selected two blocks planted in 2004—one dry farmed, low yielding block at 1040 ft with Clone 8, and another on a cooler, north-facing aspect at 690 ft with Clone 4. This mountain Cabernet vineyard produces profound, long lived wines with few equals in Sonoma County.

VINIFICATION

1.1 T of clone 4 and 1.6 T of clone 8 Cabernet Sauvignon hand-harvested on Sept 1st. Fruit was hand sorted and gently de-stemmed prior to a 5-day cold soak. Fermented for 23-days on indigenous yeasts in small steel fermenters. Wine aged for 30-months in new & used French oak barrels. Bottled unfinned/unfiltered.
