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We may not realize it, but we experience the related effects of climate change every day. The increasing amount of greenhouse gases in the air results in higher temperatures, changes in precipitation, extreme weather conditions and rising sea levels. These changes endanger our health by affecting our food and water sources and the air we breathe. Once we damage our environment, it's difficult to reverse those negative impacts. In 2020, California experienced its worst wildfire season on record. There were 9,917 fires that burned almost 4.3 million acres of land, the largest ever recorded.
