Theme: Home of the Free and the Brave

What makes the USA special?

Reading- How to blend sounds for reading and writing.

Blending Phonemes- /c/ /a/ /t/ = cat

Blending Word Parts- /c/ /at/ = cat

Writing



Have your child practice writing the child by asking them to draw a picture of an event, special place, special person that they did something with. Practice retelling all the details of the moment. Then ask your child to write 1 – 2 simple sentences about their drawing. Encourage your child to use what they are learning about making words using letter sounds to write. They can also use the “**Words to Know**” from above in their writing.
