We refer to the Request for Qualifications ("RFQ") for the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority Thermal Generation Facilities project (the "Project") issued by the Puerto Rico Public-Private Partnerships Authority (the "P3 Authority") on August 10, 2020, and your statement of qualifications ("SOQ") submitted pursuant to the RFQ. Capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the RFQ.

The Board of Directors of the P3 Authority established a partnership committee for the Project (the "PPP Committee") as required by the Puerto Rico Public-Private Partnership Act (Act 29-2009), as amended ("Act 29"), the Puerto Rico Electric System Transformation Act (Act 120-2018), as amended ("Act 120"), and the Regulation for the Procurement, Evaluation, Selection, Negotiation and Award of Partnership Contracts and Sale Contracts for the Transformation of the Electric System under Act No. 120-2018, as amended (the "Regulation"). The PPP Committee is responsible for evaluating and pre-qualifying the entities that submitted responses to the RFQ and selecting those most qualified to participate as proponents for the Projects under a Request for Proposal ("RFP") process.

Pursuant to the Regulation, the PPP Committee may identify a limited number of entities that submitted responses to the RFQ in order to arrive at a shortlist of Qualified Respondents for the Project. Accordingly, Section 1.4 of the RFQ provides that "[T]he PPP Committee reserves the right in its absolute discretion to limit the number of Respondents it considers to be qualified in order to arrive at a shortlist of Qualified Respondents that allows for an orderly procurement".





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### Puerto Rico Public-Private Partnerships Authority

On or before September 15, 2020, the P3 Authority received fifteen (15) statements of qualification (“SOQs”) in response to the RFQ. The PPP Committee evaluated the technical and legal components of each SOQ and each response to the P3 Authority’s Request for Clarifications (“RFCs”) in accordance with the criteria and requirements set forth in Sections 3 and 4 of the RFQ. As part of their evaluation process, the PPP Committee assessed each Respondent’s compliance with the rules set forth in the RFQ, and the legal and regulatory requirements set forth in Act 29, Act 120 and the Regulation.

Each Respondent was evaluated solely on the basis of the contents of its SOQ, including its responses to the P3 Authority’s RFCs. Other than the RFCs, the PPP Committee did not engage in any oral or written communications with any Respondent during the evaluation process.

After careful evaluation of Beowulf Energy LLC’s submission against the RFQ criteria, the PPP Committee determined that Beowulf Energy LLC had not met the requirements of the RFQ. As a result, Beowulf Energy LLC was not included in the shortlist of Qualified Respondents for the Project.

As set forth in Act 29 and the Regulation, the P3 Authority will not entertain any request for reconsideration of the shortlisting decision. As a Respondent that was not shortlisted as part of the RFQ process, you have the right to request judicial review of the P3 Authority’s decision, which right is governed by the provisions of Section 20 of Act 29 and Section 9.2 of the Regulation. Section 20 of Act 29 provides a jurisdictional term of twenty (20) days from the date of this letter to file a writ for administrative review before the Court of Appeals (as such term is defined in Act 29). If the date of issuance of this notice is different from its mailing by certified mail, the term





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shall be counted as of the date of its mailing as provided in said Section 20(b). A copy of Act 29 is available on the P3 Authority's webpage.

Consistent with prior practices, the Governor of Puerto Rico may make a public announcement identifying the Qualified Respondents.
