Your philanthropy deserves respect and trust. To assure that Piedmont CASA merits your full confidence, we declare that our donors have these rights:

- I. To be informed of Piedmont CASA's mission and of the way the we intend to use donated resources.
- II. To be assured gifts will be used effectively for the purposes for which they were given.
- III. To feel free to ask questions when making a donation, knowing that you will receive prompt, truthful and forthright answers.
- IV. To receive appropriate acknowledgment and recognition.
- V. To be assured that information about your donation is handled with respect and with confidentiality to the extent provided by law.
- VI. To know that Piedmont CASA does not, and will not, share our supporter mailing lists with other individuals or organizations.
- VII. To expect that all relationships with individuals representing organizations of interest to our donors will be professional in nature.
- VIII. To be informed of the identity of those serving on Piedmont CASA's governing board, and to expect the board to exercise prudent judgment in its stewardship responsibilities.
- IX. To have access to Piedmont CASA's most recent financial statements.
