Instructional Focus

As a community, we will focus on explicit instruction to strengthen reading and mathematical literacy.

Theory of Action: If teachers use explicit literacy instruction to teach skills such as identifying the main idea, making inferences, and understanding vocabulary, then students will develop higher-order thinking skills, enabling them to analyze, evaluate, and connect ideas in informational texts, thereby improving their reading comprehension.

Explicit Instruction follows a sequence of steps:

1. Identify a clear, specific learning objective.
2. Break information into chunks.
3. Model with clear explanations
4. Verbalize the thinking process.
5. Provide opportunities for students to practice.
6. Give feedback.

- The development of vocabulary, grammar, reading comprehension and writing will be achieved through the study of literal and informative texts on various high interest topics.

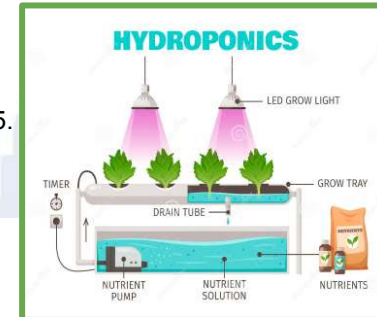
Library Skills teacher for classes: 601 - 602
