Text-code logins end February 1, 2027

Microsoft is retiring SMS and voice sign-in codes from Microsoft Entra ID. If anyone at your firm logs in to Microsoft 365 with a six-digit text, that method stops working. Here is what changes, when, and how to get ahead of it.

Sept 1, 2026

AUTO-ENABLEMENT

Microsoft turns on passkeys for anyone using text or voice codes and begins prompting them to register at sign-in.

Feb 1, 2027

SMS & VOICE RETIRED

Microsoft-provided text and voice codes are fully retired. Six-digit texts stop being a sign-in option.

After Feb 1

BLOCKING · NO OPT-OUT

Users whose only method was a text code must register a passkey before they can sign in again. Applies to every organization.

Why Microsoft is doing this

Texted codes can be phished, intercepted, or stolen with a SIM swap, and they are behind a large share of account takeovers. Passkeys replace codes with the same thing that unlocks your phone: Face ID, a fingerprint, or a device PIN. Nothing to type, nothing to intercept.

Moving users to passkeys carries no Microsoft fee. Keeping SMS after the deadline requires contracting a third-party telecom provider, billed per message.

- ✓ Sign in with a glance or a touch instead of waiting on a text
- ✓ One passkey, securely synced across devices
- ✓ Nothing for attackers to phish or SIM-swap
- ✓ Fewer lockouts while traveling or off-signal
- ✓ Cleaner answers on cyber insurance and client security questionnaires
