When assurance arrives in 2028, have the proof already filmed, dated and filed.

Your first mandatory IFRS S1 and S2 period begins on 1 January 2027. Limited assurance follows in 2028. Much of the evidence for what you disclose can only be captured while it is happening.

When limited assurance begins, someone will point to a line in your report and ask for the evidence behind it. Some of that evidence is paperwork. Much of it is not. It is the site as it stood, the new equipment on the day it was commissioned, the community programme with people actually in the room. Once that moment has passed, it cannot be filmed again.

What makes a film record hold up under assurance

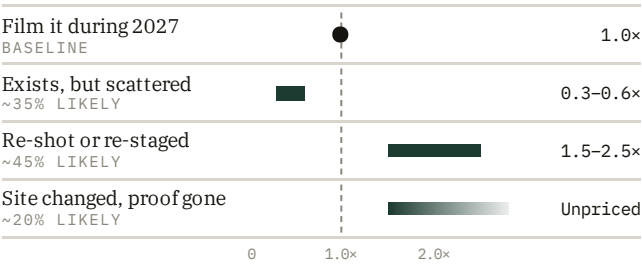
- Filmed on your working sites, under your safety permits.
- Everyone on camera signs a Data Protection Act release.
- Every clip keeps its recorded date and GPS location.
- A digital fingerprint on every file exposes any alteration.
- Untouched originals are stored apart from the edits.
- Each clip is filed against the disclosure line it supports, and delivered on request within an agreed time.

What you receive

The field record: an archive of every site and programme your disclosure describes. **A board and AGM film** that explains the finished disclosure to people who are not specialists. **Your key figures**, drawn as charts and motion graphics. A single-period option suits budgets already set.

What waiting is likely to cost

Cost of reconstructing the evidence in 2028, against filming it during 2027.



Weighting the outcomes that can be priced, waiting saves nothing: an expected **0.8–1.3×** the cost of filming now. And one time in five, the proof is simply gone, with no budget that can bring it back.
