Our Shul, Our Community

A diverse group of families from all over the world gather in a small bomb-shelter-turned-shul each week. They welcome Shabbos with uplifting tefillos, spirited singing, and powerful, practical Torah from the Rav. They catch a good shmooze with like-minded friends after davening. It's this kehila that keeps them grounded and growing as they navigate life in the unfamiliar country they now call home.

This is Kehilas Avreichim, providing a support system and a sense of community to Anglo families in Har Nof for the past 16 years.

More Than Just a Place to Daven

We are a flourishing and close-knit community. There is programming for all ages, an active Shabbos and Yom Tov Kollel, and weekly va'adim with Rabbi Brazil focusing on personal development. Ladies' events and children's fundays get the whole family involved and connected.

But we have long outgrown our current premises, a rented bomb shelter.

As our shul grows, we need more:

- More space, opening our shul to everyone who wants to be part of the tefillos
- More events, bringing the community closer together
- More Torah, in a purpose-built beis medrash

Kehilas Avreichim is growing. We aspire to create a central community hub, a building where we can thrive.

OUR LEADERSHIP



Rabbi Avigdor Brazil is the guiding force of our kehila, bringing to the shul his many years of experience as a mashgiach, maggid shiur, and rosh kollel.

He is known for his legendary Friday night derashos, his clarity of hashkafa, and the unique personal attention he gives to each member of the kehila. Rabbi Brazil's energy and relatability have attracted many families, who treasure the connections they form with him, even years after they've left the shul.



Rav Yoel Rabin, a famed maggid shiur in the Mir Yeshiva, is the Rosh Chabura of our Shabbos Kollel. He is one of the foremost talmidim of Rabbi Osher Arieli. Hundreds have enjoyed his phenomenal ability to convey complex sugyas with depth and clarity.

Members of the shul learn together on Shabbos morning before Shacharis and on Shabbos afternoon, with Rav Yoel giving a high-level shiur on the sugya each week.



Empowered by the example set by the shul's leadership, many members have nurtured a desire to do something impactful for Klal Yisrael. We're proud that a high percentage of our alumni move on to Jewish leadership positions, as community rabbanim, kiruv professionals, or dynamic educators.

They have moved on from Har Nof to inspire communities all around the world.

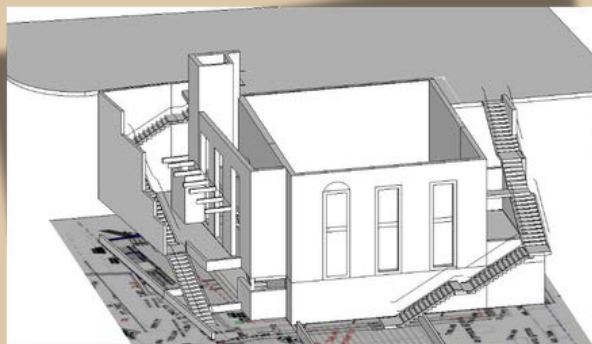
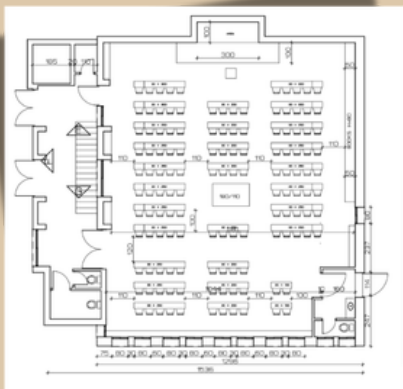
The plans include:

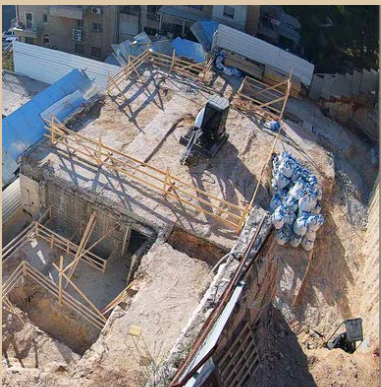
