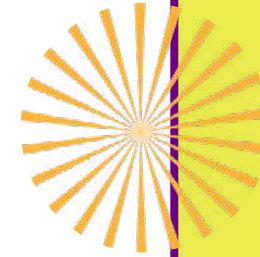
However, sometimes communities don't have enough resources to support the people who live there.
