



Reporting Suite: Document Internal Incidents

Document What Matters. Prove What Happened.

The Reporting Suite captures the incidents your agency has to get right. FORCE documents use of force, KNINE tracks K9 deployments and training, REACH records behavioral crisis response, SCOUT logs drone missions, and REVUE turns any incident into a structured after-action review. All five are built on COMS, so every report ties back to the officers, units, and policies involved. When oversight, prosecutors, or the public ask, the record is complete and ready.

The Problem

Critical incident reporting is fragmented and hard to defend.

- **Reports live everywhere.** Use of force, K9, crisis, and drone activity get logged in different systems, or not at all.
- **Reviews rely on memory.** After-action reviews depend on scattered notes and whoever remembers what happened.
- **Oversight outpaces you.** Public and legal demands for data arrive faster than your agency can pull it together.

Benefits

Capture every reportable event and stand behind the data.

- **Use of force, done right.** FORCE captures and reviews every incident against policy.
- **K9 on the record.** KNINE documents deployments and training in one standard.
- **Crisis response captured.** REACH records behavioral crisis calls and outcomes for review and transparency.
- **Drone missions logged.** SCOUT documents every UAS flight with the detail oversight expects.
- **Learn from every incident.** REVUE turns after-action reviews into structured, searchable records.



Every Report, Ready for Scrutiny.

The reports in this suite are the ones that get subpoenaed, audited, and put in front of the public. Generic incident forms don't hold up to that. The Reporting Suite captures each event against the policy it falls under, timestamps every entry, and ties it to the officers and units involved through COMS. Every report is defensible the moment it's filed. And because it all sits on one record, pulling everything tied to a single incident, or a single officer, takes seconds instead of days.

How it Works

One standard for every reportable event.

1. **Log the incident.** Officers file the right report, use of force, K9, crisis, or drone, from one system.
2. **Tie it to policy.** Each report links to the policy and standard it falls under.
3. **Attach the evidence.** Photos, video, and documents attach directly to the report record.
4. **Review after action.** REVUE structures the after-action review so lessons are captured, not lost.
5. **Produce on demand.** Pull everything tied to an incident, officer, or unit for oversight in seconds.
