



VAULT: The Agency Quartermaster

Know What You Own. Know Who Has It.

VAULT is where your agency's equipment lives. It tracks every asset from purchase through issuance, maintenance, and return, so you always know what you own, what it's worth, and who's accountable for it. Built on COMS, gear is issued to real people on your roster, so a transfer or separation flags exactly what needs to come back. No more lost gear, expired body armor, or surprise gaps at audit.

The Problem

Agencies lose track of the gear they've paid for.

- **No single inventory.** Equipment lives in spreadsheets, storerooms, and someone's memory.
- **Nobody's accountable.** When gear walks off, there's no record of who had it last.
- **Audits expose the gaps.** Missing, expired, or unaccounted items surface at the worst possible time.

Benefits

Account for every asset, from purchase to return.

- **One source of inventory.** VAULT tracks everything you own in a single system.
- **Issued to real people.** Every asset is checked out to a member on your roster, not a name on a sticky note.
- **Nothing expires unnoticed.** Track service dates, warranties, and expirations before they lapse.
- **Ready for any audit.** Pull a full, current inventory and issuance history on demand.



Gear That Knows Who's Accountable.

Most inventory systems track objects. VAULT tracks accountability. Because it's built on COMS, every item is issued to a real member, so you always know not just what you own but who's responsible for it. When someone transfers, gets promoted, or separates, VAULT flags exactly what they're holding and what has to come back. That closes the gap where gear quietly disappears, and it means your inventory and your roster never drift apart.

How it Works

From the loading dock to the officer's locker, one record.

1. **Load your inventory.** Enter what you own, from serialized weapons to bulk supplies, into one system.
2. **Issue to members.** Check gear out to real people on your roster, with a record of who has what.
3. **Track the lifecycle.** Follow each asset through maintenance, service dates, and expirations.
4. **Reconcile and audit.** Pull a current inventory and full issuance history whenever you need it.

Features

- **Asset inventory.** Track equipment, supplies, and serialized items in one system.
- **Issuance tracking.** Know exactly what's issued and to whom.
- **Lifecycle management.** Follow assets through maintenance, service, and expiration.
