- Snowboard Program
- Nordic Program
- Biathlon Program

Applicants must:

- Complete the scholarship application in its entirety and submit via email before the deadline.
- Demonstrate financial need through the information requested in the application.
- Be registered (or planning to register) for an eligible ASC program.
