

Proliant Dairy, LLC. Privacy Policy

Thank you for visiting our website (the “Website”). Proliant Dairy, LLC (“Proliant”, “We” or “Our”) value and respect your privacy. This privacy policy (the “Privacy Policy”) is designed to assist you in understanding how we collect, use, and protect any information you may provide to us. We do not sell, rent or market your Personal Information to third parties and have no intention of doing so in the future. Your use of the Website and continued use of the Website following any changes to the Privacy Policy, signifies your consent to be legally bound by both the terms and conditions of this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree to the terms of the Privacy Policy, please do not use the Website or provide any information to us.

The Information We Collect

Except as otherwise provided in this Privacy Policy, Proliant will not collect any Personal Information about you (e.g., your name, postal address, date of birth, phone numbers, credit card numbers or email address, the latter of which, along with your domain name, may be automatically recognized when you visit our Website) through our Website unless you provide it to us voluntarily. If you do not want your Personal Information collected and used as identified in this Privacy Policy, do not submit it to us.

Personal information that you provide through the Website will be used to operate the Website, deliver the services you have requested, and inform you of other products or services from Proliant and its affiliates that may be of interest to you. Proliant may also contact you to conduct surveys or research regarding your opinion of current services or of potential new services. We only ask for as much Personal Information as is necessary to complete the activity you are requesting. As such, if you choose not to provide the Personal Information that we ask for, it is possible that you may not be able to participate in that activity or fully benefit from the functions of the Website.

Our Website is not intended for, and we do not knowingly collect any Personal Information from, children under the age of 18. If we learn we have collected or received Personal Information from a child under 18 years old without verification of parental consent, we will delete that information.

Opting In and Opting Out

You will usually be asked to agree to receive communications about special offers or programs from Proliant or our affiliated brands or divisions at the time you provide your email address to us. In the event that you provide your email address via a channel that does not include a mechanism for you to affirmatively Opt-In, such as by email, you agree that by providing your email address, you are choosing to Opt-In and that you will be responsible for opting-out of receiving future communications regarding special offers or programs.

Usage Information & Use of Information Collected

We may use standard web measurement and tracking technologies such as cookies, web server logs, web beacons, clear GIFs, and similar technologies to collect Usage Information and track how you use the Website. These technologies help us improve Website functionality, measure the success of Website features and marketing efforts, analyze traffic patterns, and enhance your online experience. For example, cookies may allow the Website to recognize when you return to a specific page or recall your information on subsequent visits to make the Website easier to use.

We may also use third-party analytics and advertising services, including tools such as Google Analytics, Meta Pixel, and LinkedIn Insight Tag, to better understand Website traffic, improve user experience, and measure the effectiveness of marketing campaigns. Some browsers offer a “Do Not Track” feature; however, because there is not yet a common understanding of how to interpret these signals, the Website does not currently respond to browser Do Not Track signals.

Your browser settings may allow you to accept or reject cookies or notify you when a cookie is sent. Please note that restricting cookies or similar technologies may limit certain Website functionality. We do not use spyware, adware, or other similarly intrusive software.

We use the information collected through the Website for legitimate business purposes, including:

- providing the services or information you request;
- responding to inquiries or transactions you initiate;
- analyzing, managing, maintaining, and improving the Website;
- sending communications, marketing materials, special offers, or other information you have opted to receive;
- administering contests, sweepstakes, or promotions;
- diagnosing technical or server-related issues; and
- carrying out any other business purpose disclosed at the time information is collected.

In compliance with applicable laws, we collect only the Personal Information reasonably necessary to complete the requested activity or transaction. We do not require you to disclose more Personal Information than is reasonably necessary to participate in Website activities.

Information submitted through website forms, chat tools, or automated communication systems may be processed using third-party customer relationship management or communication platforms.

We may share Personal Information with trusted third-party service providers, cloud-based database management providers, analytics providers, marketing support providers, or

other business partners retained by Proliant to perform services on our behalf and support Website operations. These parties are authorized to use Personal Information only as necessary to provide services to Proliant and are expected to maintain appropriate confidentiality and security protections consistent with this Privacy Policy.

Your personal data may be stored on Proliant servers and on servers operated by trusted third-party service providers located in the United States. We retain Personal Information for as long as reasonably necessary to fulfill the purposes described in this Privacy Policy, comply with legal obligations, resolve disputes, maintain business records, and enforce agreements. We consider our legal and business obligations, potential risks of harm, and nature of the information when deciding how long to retain Personal Information. At the end of the retention period, Personal Information will be deleted, destroyed, or deidentified.

We do not use automated decision-making or profiling technologies that produce legal or similarly significant effects on individuals.

Please note that certain Website features or requests may direct you to third-party websites with separate privacy policies. We encourage you to review those policies before providing any information or using those websites.

Disclosure of Your Information

We may disclose the information we collect from and about you: (a) when we have reason to believe that such disclosure is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action against someone who may be causing (whether intentionally or unintentionally) injury to or interference with our rights or property, customers or other users of the Website, or anyone else who could be harmed by such activities, or is appropriate or necessary to take precautions against liability, investigate and defend against any third-party claims or allegations, and/or protect the security or integrity of the Website; (b) to respond to judicial process and provide information to law enforcement agencies, as permitted or required by law, or in the good-faith belief that such action is necessary to comply with state and federal laws; (c) to our business partners for research, analytical and marketing purposes, and/or to our subsidiaries, affiliated companies, or other businesses or persons for the purpose of processing any request on your behalf, who will also abide by the terms of this Privacy Policy; or (d) with your consent. We may sell or buy other businesses or entities. In such event, we may transfer or assign the information we have collected as part of such merger, acquisition, sale, or other change of control. In such transactions, your Personal Information may be included in the transferred business assets. Except as explained above, we will not share any of your personal information with any third party, unless we have received your express permission to do so.

Linked Sites

Our Website may contain links to other websites, including social media sites, which may have privacy policies that differ from our own. We are not responsible for the collection, use

or disclosure of information collected through third-party websites and expressly disclaim any liability related to such collection, use or disclosure. We are also not responsible for any information or content contained on such sites. Links to other websites are provided solely as a convenience. Your browsing, use and interaction on any other websites, including websites which have a link to the Website, are subject to that website's own rules and policies. Accordingly, we recommend that you review the privacy policy posted on any website that you may access through, or which links to the Website. Please note that if you provide information to us via a social media site or participate in a social media site linked to the Website, you consent to our use of your information for any reason as if it were submitted to us directly via the Website.

Security Procedures

We take commercially reasonable precautions and have implemented commercially reasonable technical measures intended to protect against the risks of unauthorized access to, erroneous disclosure of, and unlawful interception of Personal Information submitted via the Website. However, your email transmissions and/or other communications containing Personal Information may be unlawfully intercepted or accessed by third parties and/or the Website may be subject to hostile network attacks or administrative errors. We cannot and do not guarantee the security of any information transmitted over the Internet. Once we receive your Personal Information, we take steps that we believe are commercially reasonable to limit access to your Personal Information to only those employees and service providers whom we determine need access to the Personal Information to provide the requested products, services, offers or opportunities that may be of interest to you. However, even after we receive your Personal Information, we cannot guarantee that your Personal Information may not be accessed, disclosed, altered, or destroyed as a result of a breach of our commercially reasonable efforts or as a result of any other event beyond our reasonable control. Accordingly, we cannot and do not guarantee that your Personal Information is completely secure and safe from such risks. For the avoidance of doubt, WE expressly disclaim any representation or warranty, whether express or implied, with respect to ensuring, guaranteeing or otherwise offering any definitive promise of security in connection with your Personal Information or Usage Information.

In the event of a data security incident involving your Personal Information, we may notify affected individuals and regulatory authorities as required by applicable law.

Special Note to United States Users

State consumer privacy laws may provide residents with additional rights regarding use of their Personal Information. For California residents, our Website has collected the following categories of Personal Information from consumers within the last twelve (12) months: identifiers such as real name, alias, postal address, unique personal identifier, online identifier, Internet Protocol address, email address, or account name; personal information, such as name, signature, address, or telephone number; and internet or other similar network activity related to your interaction with the Website. In the twelve months prior to the effective date of this Privacy Policy, Proliant has not sold any Personal Information of consumers, as those terms are defined under the California Consumer Privacy Act ("CCPA").

The CCPA provides California residents with specific rights regarding their personal information. This section describes your CCPA rights and explains how to exercise those rights. You have the right to request that we disclose certain information to you about our collection and use of your Personal Information over the past 12 months (the "right to know"). Once we receive your request and confirm your identity, we will disclose to you: the categories of Personal Information we collected about you, the categories of sources for the Personal Information we collected about you, our business or commercial purpose for collecting that Personal Information, the categories of third parties with whom we share that Personal Information, and the specific pieces of Personal Information we collected about you. You have the right to request that we delete any of your Personal Information that we collected from you and retained, subject to certain exceptions. Once we receive your request and confirm your identity, we will review your request to see if an exception allowing us to retain the information applies. We may deny your deletion request if retaining the information is necessary to: (1) Complete the transaction for which we collected the Personal Information, provide a good or service that you requested, take actions reasonably anticipated within the context of our ongoing business relationship with you, fulfill the terms of a written warranty or product recall conducted in accordance with federal law, or otherwise perform our contract with you; (2) detect security incidents, protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity, or prosecute those responsible for such activities; (3) debug products to identify and repair errors that impair existing intended functionality; (4) exercise free speech, ensure the right of another consumer to exercise their free speech rights, or exercise another right provided for by law; (5) comply with the California Electronic Communications Privacy Act (Cal. Penal Code § 1546 et. seq.); (6) engage in public or peer-reviewed scientific, historical, or statistical research in the public interest that adheres to all other applicable ethics and privacy laws, when the information's deletion may likely render impossible or seriously impair the research's achievement, if you previously provided informed consent; (7) enable solely

internal uses that are reasonably aligned with consumer expectations based on your relationship with us; (8) comply with a legal obligation; or (9) make other internal and lawful uses of that information that are compatible with the context in which you provided it. We will delete or deidentify Personal Information not subject to one of these exceptions from our records and will direct our service providers to take similar action. You may only submit a request to know twice within a 12-month period. Your request to know or delete must provide sufficient information that allows us to reasonably verify you are the person about whom we collected Personal Information or an authorized representative, and describe your request with sufficient detail that allows us to properly understand, evaluate, and respond to it. We will confirm receipt of your request within ten (10) business days. If you do not receive confirmation within the 10-day timeframe, please contact dairyingredients@proliantinc.com. We endeavor to substantively respond to a verifiable consumer request within forty-five (45) days of its receipt. If we require more time (up to another 45 days), we will inform you of the reason and extension period in writing. We do not charge a fee to process or respond to your verifiable consumer request unless it is excessive, repetitive, or manifestly unfounded.

Special Note to International Users

By using the Website, you agree and acknowledge that the Website is hosted in the United States. If you are attempting to access the Website from a physical location within the European Union, Asia, or any other region with laws or regulations governing personal data collection, use, and disclosure that differ from United States laws, please be advised that through your continued use of the Website, which is governed by U.S. law, and the Privacy Notice, you are transferring your Personal Information to the United States and, except as may be required by other applicable rules, regulations, case law, and/or

international treaties resulting in the application of the laws of a jurisdiction other than the United States or the State of Iowa, you consent to (i) such transfer, (ii) the application of the laws of the United States and/or the State of Iowa with respect to any dispute arising from or related to the Privacy Policy and/or your use of the Website and (iii) the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of the State of Iowa and the federal courts sitting in Des Moines, Iowa. Any claim or dispute between you and us that arises in whole or in part from your use of the Website or in connection with the Privacy Policy shall be decided exclusively by a court of competent jurisdiction located in Des Moines, Iowa, U.S.A. Each party hereby agrees that such court shall have personal jurisdiction and venue with respect to such party, and each party hereby submits to the personal jurisdiction and venue of such courts and waives any objection based on inconvenient forum.
